THE DEFENCE (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS.

ORDER made by the Governor under Regulation 43c of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations.

Order.

Where by virtue of—

(a) any agreement between an employer and the labourers employed by him in any essential service; or

(b) any award duly made under the Essential Services (Avoidance of Strikes and Lockouts) Order, 1942, after the date on which this Order is published in the *Gazette* on any trade dispute between any employer and any such labourers; or

(c) any provision of law applying in the case of any employer and any such labourers,

the employer is under an obligation to provide a free mid-day meal to the labourers or any of the labourers, any agreement of any description, entered into by the employer with such labourers or any of such labourers, to commute the obligation wholly or in part by any payment made in money, as an allowance in addition to the ordinary wages of such labourers, shall be unlawful.

THE DEFENCE (TRADING WITH THE ENEMY) REGULATIONS, 1939.
