THE DEFENCE (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS.

Order under Regulation 2.

IN the exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 2 of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do hereby declare all service, work or labour of any description whatsoever, rendered or performed by persons engaged or employed in, or in connexion with; the undertaking specified in the item set out hereunder, in the course of their business or employment, to be a service of public utility, essential for the prosecution of the war and

essential to the life of the community, whether the remuneration in the case of such persons is computed or paid on a daily, weekly or monthly basis or otherwise; and accordingly, the Order under the aforesaid Regulation published in *Gazette* No. 8,915 of April 17, 1942, as amended by any subsequent Order, is hereby further amended by the insertion, at the end of paragraph 3 of the Schedule to that Order, of the item set out hereunder.
