RAZOR BLADES.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Glanville Sextus Peiris, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) for the Island, do, by this Order-

- (i.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the importer's maximum prices (to a wholesale dealer), the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which razor blades of the descriptions specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
  (ii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
- - (a) any sale for the purpose of resale or any sale of ten or more packets of the razor blades referred to in the

Schedule hereto to any one person in the course of one transaction, shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale.

(b) any sale of razor blades, referred to in Schedule hereto, other than a sale by wholesale as defined above, shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;

(iii.) direct that any trader, who at any premises in Ceylon, sell, any razor blades of the description specified in the

Schedule hereto, shall exhibit m a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of razor blades of those descriptions;

(iv.) direct that every trader, who has at any time during the three months prior to this date dealt in any razor blades of the descriptions specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of it available for sale, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises a notice to the effect that he has no stocks of such razor blades available for sale, for the time being;

(v.) direct that every trader who sells any razor blades of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule shall give to every purchaser of such razor blades, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out-

- (a) the quantity and description of the razor blades sold;
- (b) the price paid;(c) the date of the sale; and
- (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.
