GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS. PRICE ORDERS.

RAZOR BLADES.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Glanville Sextus Peiris, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) for the Island, do, by this Order—

- (i.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the importer's maximum prices (to a wholesale dealer), the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which razor blades of the descriptions specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (ii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale for the purpose of resale or any sale of ten or more packets of the razor blades referred to in the Schedule hereto to any one person in the course of one transaction, shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale.
 - (b) any sale of razor blades, referred to in Schedule hereto, other than a sale by wholesale as defined above, shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iii.) direct that any trader, who at any premises in Ceylon, sell, any razor blades of the description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of razor blades of those descriptions;
- (iv.) direct that every trader, who has at any time during the three months prior to this date dealt in any razor blades of the descriptions specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of it available for sale, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises a notice to the effect that he has no stocks of such razor blades available for sale, for the time being;
- (v.) direct that every trader who sells any razor blades of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule shall give to every purchaser of such razor blades, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the quantity and description of the razor blades sold;
 - (b) the price paid;
 - (c) the date of the sale; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated April 6, 1943, on blue published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,108 of April 9, 1943, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of "Shamrock" blue;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in
 - (a) columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the importer's maximum price (to a wholesale dealer), and the maximum wholesale price; and
 - (b) columns 4 and 5 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices above which blue of the description specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale for the purpose of resale of any article specified in the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;

- (b) any sale for the purpose of use of any article specified in the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;
- (c) " maximum wholesale price " shall apply to all sales by wholesale except sales by an importer to a wholesale dealer ;
- (d) " maximum retail price " shall apply to all sales by retail ;
- (iv.) direct that every person who sells blue of the description specified in the Schedule hereto shall give to the purchaser of such blue on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- (a) the quantity and description of the blue sold ;
- (b) the price paid ; and
- (c) the date and place of sale ;
- (v.) direct that any trader who, at any premises, sells blue of any description specified in the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of blue of that description.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date Price Order dated May 18, 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,274 of May 26, 1944 ;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto, to be, respectively, the importer's maximum price (to a wholesale dealer), the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which tooth paste of the description specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon ;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
- (a) any sale for the purpose of resale or any sale of the tooth paste referred to in the Schedule hereto, to any one person in the course of one transaction, shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale ;
- (b) any sale of tooth paste, referred to in the Schedule hereto, other than a sale by wholesale as defined above, shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;
- (iv.) direct that any trader, who, at any premises in Ceylon, sells any tooth paste of the description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of tooth paste of that description ;
- (v.) direct that every trader, who has at any time during the three months prior to this date dealt in any tooth paste of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of it available for sale, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises a notice to the effect that he has no stocks of such tooth paste available for sale for the time being ;
- (vi.) direct that every trader, who sells any tooth paste of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule, shall give to every purchaser of such tooth paste, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- (a) the quantity and description of the tooth paste sold ;
- (b) the price paid ;
- (c) the date of the sale ; and
- (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail ;

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date Order dated January 4, 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,237 of February 11, 1944, in so far as it relates to the prices fixed in respect of galvanized plug cocks and galvanized stop valves mentioned in the Schedule thereto ;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale prices and the maximum retail prices above which pipe fittings of the description and size specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in Ceylon ;

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated September 15, 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,312 of September 22, 1944, in so far as it relates to the maximum retail prices fixed in respect of wire nails mentioned in the Schedule thereto ;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale prices and the maximum retail prices above which wire nails of the description and sizes specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon ;
