TOOTH PASTE.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

By virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date Price Order dated September 11, 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,311 of September 15, 1944;
- (ii) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the manufacturer's maximum price to a wholesale dealer, the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which tooth paste of the description and size specified in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale for the purpose of resale of the tooth paste referred to in the Schedule shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale for the purpose of use of the tooth paste referred to in the Schedule shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iv) direct that every person, who sells any tooth paste specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser of such tooth paste, on demand, a receipt there shall be set out—
 - (a) the quantity, description and size of the tooth paste sold;

- (b) the price paid;
- (c) the date of the sale; and
- (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the transaction was by wholesale or by retail;

- (v) direct that any trader, who, at any premises in Ceylon, sells any tooth paste of the description and size specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of tooth paste of that description and size.

WRITING INK (LOCALLY MANUFACTURED).

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Glanville Sextus Peiris, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) for the Island, do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date Price Order dated August 24, 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,305 of August 25, 1944, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of all types of locally manufactured ink;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3, and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the manufacturer's maximum price (to a wholesale dealer), the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which writing ink of the description and size specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (iii.) direct that every person, who at any premises in Ceylon, sells Writing Ink of the description and size specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of Writing Ink of that description and size;
- (iv.) direct that any person, who at any premises deals or has at any time during the three months prior to this date dealt in Writing Ink of the description and size mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of such Writing Ink available for sale, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at these premises a notice to the effect that he has no stocks available for sale for the time being;
- (v.) direct that every person, who sells Writing Ink of the description and size specified in column 1. of the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date and place of sale;
 - (b) the description and size of Writing Ink sold;
 - (c) the quantity of Writing Ink sold;
 - (d) price paid.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Glanville Sextus Peiris, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) for the Island, do, by this Order—

- (i.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale prices and the maximum retail prices above which the article, specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (ii.) direct that every dealer, who at any premises in Ceylon sell the article described in the column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises the maximum prices fixed by this Order for the article of the description given in column 1.

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date Order on Galvanized Wire Staples dated August 26, 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,166 of September 3, 1944;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale prices and the maximum retail prices above which articles of the descriptions and sizes specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date Price Order dated September 26, 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,314 of September 29, 1944;
- (ii.) fix the price specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto, to be, respectively, the importer's

maximum price (to a wholesale dealer), the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which tooth paste of the description specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;

(iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—

- (a) any sale for the purpose of resale or any sale of the tooth paste referred to in the Schedule hereto, to any one person in the course of one transaction, shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
- (b) any sale of tooth paste, referred to in the Schedule hereto, other than a sale by wholesale as defined above, shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;

(iv.) direct that any trader, who, at any premises in Ceylon, sells any tooth paste of the description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of tooth paste of that description;

(v.) direct that every trader who has at any time during the three months prior to this date dealt in any tooth paste of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of it available for sale, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises a notice to the effect that he has no stocks of such tooth paste available for sale for the time being;

(vi.) direct that every trader who sells any tooth paste of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule shall give to every purchaser of such tooth paste, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the quantity and description of the tooth paste sold;
- (b) the price paid;
- (c) the date of the sale; and
- (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date, Order dated August 9, 1944, appearing in *Government Gazette* No. 9,302 of August 13, 1944;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively maximum wholesale and retail prices above which linseed oil of the descriptions specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold by wholesale or retail in Ceylon;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order, any sale of any linseed oil for the purpose of resale, shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
- (iv.) direct that for the purpose of this Order, any sale of any linseed oil for the purpose of use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;

- (i.) fix the prices specified in columns 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale and retail prices respectively above which lamps and lanterns of the description, and make specified in columns 1 and 2 respectively of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in Ceylon;
- (ii.) direct that for the purpose of this order, any sale for the purpose of use of any lamp or lantern of the description, and make specified in columns 1 and 2 respectively, of the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by retail and any sale for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
- (iii.) direct that every dealer who, at any premises in Ceylon sells any lamp or lantern of the description and make specified in columns 1 and 2 respectively, of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices, fixed for such lamps or lanterns by this Order.
