GERRARD AND GRIPLOCK STRAPPING WIRE.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

(i.) revoke with effect from this date Order dated October 19, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,185 of October 22, 1943, in so far as it relates to the prices fixed in respect of Gerrard and Griplock Strapping Wire mentioned in the Schedule thereto;

(ii.) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale prices and the maximum retail prices above which articles of the descriptions and sizes specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;

- (1) Revoke with effect from this date my Orders on Rice, Whole Wheat, and Bajri (Cambu) dated—
- (a) November 25, 1943, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 9,209 of December 3, 1943,
- (b) July 12, 1944, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 9,295 of July 21, 1944,
