SHEET (WINDOW) GLASS.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated September 10, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,173 of September 17, 1943, in so far as it relates to sheet or window glass (plain).
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively, the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which glass of the description specified in the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) sale of any glass specified in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) sale of any glass specified in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iv.) direct that every dealer who at any premises in Ceylon sells any glass of the description specified in the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order for glass of the description specified in the Schedule hereto;
- (v.) direct that every person, who sells any glass of the description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall

give to every purchaser of such articles a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the description and quantity of the glass sold;
- (b) the price paid; and
- (c) the date and place of sale.

BICYCLES.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date my Orders—
 - (a) dated September 3, 1943, on bicycles published *Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,167 of September 4, 1943;
 - (b) dated September 9, 1943, on bicycles published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,170 of September 10, 1943;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be, the maximum retail price above which bicycles of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale for the purpose of use of bicycles mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (b) retail prices shall apply to all sales by retail;
- (iv.) direct that any trader, who at any premises in Ceylon sells any bicycles of the description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of bicycles of that description;
- (v.) direct that every person who sells any of the bicycles specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser of such bicycles a receipt, on demand, in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the quantity and description of the bicycles sold;
 - (b) the price paid; and
 - (c) the date and place of sale.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph 2 of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric

Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) for the Island do, by this Order—

(i.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price and maximum retail price, above which the article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;

(ii.) direct that every dealer who at any premises in Ceylon sells the article described in the column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises the maximum prices fixed by this Order for the article of the description given in column 1;

(iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—

(a) any sale, for the purpose of resale of any quantity of the article described in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall be described to be a sale by wholesale;

(b) any sale, for the purpose of use of any quantity of the article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;

(c) "maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale;

(d) "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail;

(iv.) direct that every person who sells the article of the description in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall give to every purchaser of the said article, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—

(a) the quantity, description and size of the article sold;

(b) the price paid; and

(c) the date of sale.
