THE DEFENCE (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS.

The Controlled Articles (Electric Torches and Torch Batteries) Order, 1943, published in Gazette No. 9,142 of July 2, 1943, is hereby amended as follows:—

- in paragraphs 7, 8 (1), 8 (2) and 12 by the omission of the words "or battery" wherever those words occur collectively therein;
 by the substitution for paragraph 13 of the following new
- paragraph:-
 - "13. Every person to whom a permit has been granted under this Order shall, before taking delivery of the new torch to which the permit relates—
 - (a) affix his signature (or his thumb-print, if he is unable to write) to the permit in the presence of the authorised dealer; and

- (b) surrender the permit to that dealer."; and
- (3) in paragraph 14, by the omission of the words "or any new battery".
