## GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS.

TEXTILES CONTROL.

Order No. 4.

IN the exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulations 8 and 9 of the Defence (Control of Textiles) (No. 1) Regulations, 1943, I hereby direct that no regulated textiles manufactured on handlooms and imported to Ceylon after the 31st day of October, 1944, shall be sold or exposed for sale—

- (i.) by retail, at prices higher than the prices indicated in columns 8, 9 and 10 of Schedule A.
- (ii.) by wholesale, at prices higher than the maximum retail prices indicated in columns 8, 9, and 10 of Schedule A reduced by fifteen per centum.

2. Where any such regulated textile imported into Ceylon does not correspond to any individual item in Schedule A and the Controller in the exercise of his powers under Regulations 8 and 9 has by special order prescribed and caused to be stamped upon such regulated textile such price as he may have deemed appropriate, no such regulated textile shall be sold by retail at a price exceeding the price so stamped, or by wholesale at a price higher than the maximum retail price, so stamped reduced by fifteen per centum.

3. Where a maximum retail price is stamped under the direction of the Controller of Textiles on any regulated textile manufactured on a handloom and imported to Ceylon before November 1, 1944, such textile shall not be sold by retail at a price higher than the price so stamped, or by wholesale at a price exceeding such maximum retail price reduced by 15 per centum.

4. Regulated textiles manufactured on a handloom and imported to Ceylon before November 1, 1944, and not stamped with a maximum retail price under the direction of the Controller of Textiles may continue until November 30, 1944, to be sold at the regulated price under regulation 3 of the Defence (Control of Textiles) (No. 1) Regulations, 1943, as amended by any subsequent regulation.

5. No regulated textile which has not been stamped with the maximum retail price under the direction of the Controller of Textiles shall be sold or exposed for sale on and after December 1, 1944.

6. A dealer who is in possession of regulated textiles which are not stamped with the maximum retail price at the close of business on November 30, 1944, may send to the Assistant Controller of Textiles, Price Marking, at No. 213, Main street, Pettah, Colombo, a statement of such textiles in his possession.

7. On receipt of a statement of textiles as provided in paragraph 6 of this Order, the Assistant Controller of Textiles, Price Marking, shall stamp such textiles with maximum retail prices calculated as provided by Textiles Control Order No. 1, dated September 4, 1944, or by paragraphs 1 and 2 of this Order or where these Orders are not applicable under Regulation 3 of Defence (Control of Textiles) (No. 1) Regulations, 1943, as amended by any subsequent Regulations.

Such textiles may be sold after they have been so price-marked but not at prices exceeding the maximum prices so stamped on them.

8. For the purposes of this Order the date when goods are cleared from the Customs shall be deemed to be the date of import.

9. The information contained in Schedule A shall be interpreted subject to the explanatory notes contained in Schedule B.

Schedule B.

Explanatory Notes.

- The word nominal is used to indicate the recognized standards of counts of yarn, length and width subject to reasonable latitude.
- The words full, half, and light applied to colours have the following meanings :—  
*Full*—means that the material contains more than 66⅔ per centum of dyed yarn.  
*Half*—means that the material contains more than 33⅓ per centum of dyed yarn but does not contain more than 66⅔ per centum of dyed yarn.  
*Light*—means that the material does not contain more than 33⅓ per centum of dyed yarn.
- The words “first quality” when used in describing any item mean that the goods are selected as being up to fair average manufacture; and the words “second quality” mean that the goods are below fair average manufacture.
- When 2 or 3 serial numbers are bracketted together, the first item represents the article as it is manufactured and imported in respect of dimensions and divisions into units. And the second and the third items represent the same material as subdivided for purposes of retail.
