THE DEFENCE (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS.

ORDER made by the Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by regulation 43n of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations.

The Controlled Articles (Cement) Order, 1943, published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 9,085 of February 13, 1943, as

amended by Order published in *Gazette* No. 9,224 of January 7, 1944, is hereby further amended by the insertion, immediately after paragraph 9c of that Order, of the following paragraph:—

- "9D. Subject as hereinafter provided, no person shall on or after the first day of March, 1945, keep in any place—
 - (a) any cement purchased or acquired from an authorised dealer unless that person is in possession of the dealer's receipt issued in respect of that cement, or
 - (b) any cement other than cement purchased or acquired from an authorised dealer except with the written sanction of the Controller:

Provided, however, that an authorised dealer may, without the written sanction of the Controller, keep in any place where he is carrying on business as such dealer any cement imported by him into Ceylon.".

THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.

Order No. 89.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (1) (g) of the Food Control Ordinance (Chapter 132), read with the Defence (Food and Price Control) (Transfer of Powers) Regulations, 1942, I, Don Stephen Senanayake, Minister for Agriculture and Lands, do by this Order direct the Food Controller to take steps for the allocation of supplies of paddy or other grain or any preparation made mainly or wholly from such grain to merchants and distributors in all parts of Ceylon and to organize and administer a system of rationing such supplies on and after the date hereof.
