THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASES ORDINANCE. Notification.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 1 of the regulations under sections 2 and 3 of the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance (Chapter 173), published in the Supplement to Gazette No. 7,481 of August 28, 1925, F, Henry Monck-Mason Moore, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Notification confirm the declaration of the "diseased locality" specified in the Schedule hereto, made by the Government Agent, Province of Uva, the proper authority in that behalf, on February 13, 1945.

Schedule.

North: Private cart road from the bungalow of the Superintendent of Blairlomond Estate, Tangamalai, and the footpath from there to Kandekeputenne and from there the village boundary of Madulla and Yalagama up to Uma Oya.

East : Uma Oya and part of Dimbulankandura.

- South: Dimbulankandure and private cart road from Neckington to Kirklese.
- West: The Provincial boundary separating Uva from the Central Province from Gonamollekande to a point near the bungalow of the Superintendent of Blairlomond Estate.
