THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF TEXTILES) (No. 8)
REGULATIONS, 1945.

DEFENCE Regulations made by the Governor by virtue of the powers vested in him by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, of the Imperial Parliament, as adapted, modified and extended to Ceylon by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order-in-Council, 1940.

Regulations.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence (Control of Textiles) (No. 8) Regulations, 1945.

2. The Defence (Control of Textiles) (No. 1) Regulations, 1943, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,102 of March 22, 1943, as amended by any subsequent defence regulation, are hereby further amended in the First Schedule,—

- (a) by the substitution in the heading, Group A, for the words "Wool, less than 50 per cent. of art silk, silk or material other than cotton, unless otherwise specified against every item.", of the words "Wool, Silk, Art Silk or any Mixture of Silk, Art Silk and Cotton, or any two of them";
- (b) in item (9) by the deletion of the words "exclusive of embroidered sarees having a gold, silver or embroidered border";
- (c) in item (12) by the deletion of the words "exclusive of imports from the United Kingdom";
- (d) in item (17) by the deletion of the words "exclusive of embroidered voiles."

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
