THE DEFENCE (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS.

ORDER made by the Governor by virtue of the powers vested in him by regulation 43 of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations.

Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Lighting Restriction (Motor Cars) (No. 4) Order.

2. During the continuance in force of this Order, the operation of the Lighting Restriction (Motor Cars) Order, 1942, shall be suspended in the area referred to in that Order as the area within the Municipal limits of Colombo.

3. The Lighting Restriction (Motor Cars) (No. 3) Order, published in Gazette No. 9,302 of August 18, 1944, is hereby amended in paragraph 2 as follows:-

(1) by the substitution, in sub-paragraph (2), for the words "suspended; and", of the word "suspended.";

(2) by the omission of sub-paragraph (3).

This Order shall be read and construed as one with the Lighting Restriction Order, 1940.

THE WAR DAMAGE (BUSINESS AND PERSONAL MOVABLES) ORDINANCE, No. 9 of 1942.
