### GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS. PRICE ORDERS.

#### SOAP.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

#### Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provision No. 2) Regulations, I, Glanville Sextus Peiris, Acting Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

(i.) revoke with effect from this date Orders—

- (a) dated January 3, 1944, on soap (Imported) published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,224 of January 7, 1944;
- (b) dated July 10, 1945, on soap (locally manufactured) published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,431 of July 13, 1945, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of Sunlight Soap (household) mentioned in the Schedule thereto;

(ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3, and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the manufacturer's or importer's maximum price to a wholesale dealer per case, the maximum wholesale price per case and the maximum retail price per tablet as the case may be above which soap of the description and grade specified in the corresponding entry in column 1. of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold by wholesale or by retail, as the case may be, in any part of Ceylon;

(iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—

- (a) any sale of any quantity of any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
- (b) any sale of any quantity of any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (c) "wholesale dealer" shall mean any person who has been in the habit of selling for resale any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (d) "manufacturer's or importer's maximum price" shall apply to any sale by wholesale by a manufacturer or importer to a wholesale dealer;
- (e) "maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale except sales by a manufacturer or importer to a wholesale dealer;
- (f) "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail;

(iv.) direct that every trader who at any premises in Ceylon exhibits for sale soap of any description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of soap of that description;

(v.) direct that every person who sells soap of the description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of that soap a receipt, on demand, in which there shall be set out;

- (a) the date of the sale;
- (b) the quantity of soap sold;
- (c) the description and grade of soap sold;

- (d) the price paid for the quantity of soap sold; and
- (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;

(vi.) direct that every trader who has at any time during the three months prior to this date sold any article mentioned in the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of that article available for sale shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises a notice to the effect that stocks of that article are not available for sale for the time being.

#### WHEAT FLOUR.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

#### Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Siavax Hirji Wadia, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) for the Province of Uva, do by this Order—

(i.) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated July 30, 1943, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,154 of August 6, 1943, dated November 4, 1943, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,196 of November 12, 1943, and Food Price Order No. BD 4 dated October 23, 1944, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,324, dated October 27, 1944, in so far as it fixes maximum prices of wheat flour for the Province of Uva;

(ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price per 148 lb. net, and the maximum retail price per lb. above which wheat flour shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;

(iii.) direct that for the purposes of this Order—

- (a) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be sale by wholesale;
- (b) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;

- (iv.) direct that in every area where the maximum prices are fixed by this Order no person shall sell any wheat flour, which is adulterated with any article;
- (v.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has any wheat flour in his possession or under his control at any place, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area;
- (vi.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this order, every person who sells any wheat flour by wholesale, shall, and every person who sells any wheat flour by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- (a) the date of sale;
- (b) the weight of the wheat flour sold;
- (c) the price paid for the quantity of wheat flour sold;
- (d) the nature of the transaction, i.e. whether the sale was by wholesale or retail.
