THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASES ORDINANCE.

Notification.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 1 of the regulations under sections 2 and 3 of the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Orchance (Chapter 173), published in the Supplement to Gazette No. 7,481 of August 28. 1925, I, Henry Monck-Mason Moore, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Notification confirm the declaration of the "diseased locality" specified in the Schedule hereto, made by the Charman of the Kurunegala Urban Council, the proper authority in that behalf, on July 17, 1945.

Schedule.

The area bounded as follows:-

North: From a point at the mile post marked 59½ on the Railway line along an imaginary straight line due East until it meets the eastern boundary of the Urban Council limits.

East: From the last mentioned point along the eastern boundary of the Urban Council limits up to the point where it meets the southern boundary of the Urban Council limits.

South: From the last mentioned point along the southern boundary of the Urban Council limits until it meets the foot-path running between -premises Nos. 258 and 260 on Kandy Road.

West: From the last mentioned point in a straight line to the mile pots marked 59 on the railway line and thence along the railway line up to the starting point of the northern boundary of the diseased area.
