A PROCLAMATION.

HENRY MOORE.

KNOW Ye that, in the exercise of the powers vested in me by section 5 of the Courts Ordinance (Chapter 6) and after consultation with the Judges of the Supreme Court, I, Henry Monck-Mason Moore, Governor of Ceylon, do, with effect from October 1, 1945, by this Proclamation—

- (1) alter the division of the Western Circuit into districts, as set out in section 4 of that Ordinance, by the division of that Circuit into the eight districts which are specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto and the limits of which are set out in that Part; and
- (2) alter the division of the Southern Circuit into districts as set out in the aforesaid section 4, by the division of that Circuit into the four districts which are specified in Part II of that Schedule and the limits of which are set out in that Part.

KNOW Ye that, in the exercise of the powers vested in me by section 52 of the Courts Ordinance (Chapter 6), I, Henry Monk-Mason Moore, Governor of Ceylon, do, with effect from October 1, 1945, by this Proclamation—

- (1) establish a District Court within the district of Panadure in the Western Circuit and appoint the town of Panadure in that district as the place at which that Court shall be holden; and
- (2) establish a District Court within the district of Balapitiya in the Southern Circuit and appoint the town of Balapitiya in that district as the place at which that Court shall be holden.
