PULSES.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I. Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulter, Controller of Prices (Food), do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date my Food Price Order No. C—58 published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,391 of April 6, 1945, and my Food Price Order No. C—64 published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,435 of July 20, 1945, in so far as they fix maximum prices above which the articles specified in the Schedule hereto

should not be sold within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo;

- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the First Schedule hereto to be respectively the importer's maximum price, the maximum wholesale price per cwt. gross, the maximum wholesale price per lb. net, and the maximum retail price per lb. net above which the articles specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo;

- (iii.) direct that for the purposes of this Order—

- (a) any sale of any quantity of any article for the purpose of resale or any sale of any article in a quantity of one cwt. gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
- (b) any sale of any quantity less than one cwt. gross of any article for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
