MISCELLANEOUS LAND NOTICES.

Tenders for the Right to gem in Crown Lands.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Government Agent of the Province of Sabaragamuwa will receive sealed tenders for the right to gem for a period of one year in the under-mentioned Crown lands situated in the Ratnapura District of the Province of Sabaragamuwa.

2. The tenders which must be enclosed in sealed envelopes superscribed "Tender for the Right to Gem" will be received at the Ratnapura Kachcheri until 10.30 A.M. on February 6, 1946, when they will be opened and all persons making tenders will be required to be present or satisfy the Government Agent, Province of Sabaragamuwa, by some duly accredited agent or agents that the tender is *bona fide*.

3. The person whose tender is accepted by the Government Agent will be required to deposit the full amount of his tender at once in cash, and to enter into a lease permit on Form G.A.—A 133 for the due fulfilment of the conditions on which the tender is accepted.

4. The amount deposited is liable to forfeiture if the tenderer fails to enter into a lease permit within one month from the date of acceptance of the tender.

5. The lessee shall be liable to pay for any trees in the land damaged, felled, or uprooted during his occupancy of the said land.

6. The Government Agent, Province of Sabaragamuwa, reserves to himself the right, without question, of rejecting any or all tenders and the right of accepting any portion of a tender.

7. The tenderers whose tenders are accepted should deposit in respect of each land such security not exceeding Rs. 100 as is approved by the Government Agent, Province of Sabaragamuwa, for filling up of pits and against breaches of the conditions of the permit.

6. A portion of the bed of the stream called Paragala-ganga being part of lot 215 in F. V. P. 224, situated at Paragala in Kukul korale about 10 chains in length within the following boundaries:—

North by Moragahatota.

East by Dickowitawatta lots 73 and 74.

South by confluence of Pokunudola.

West by Kukulumoderawatta lots 230 and 235.

7. The land called Ambagahadeniyahalakella being lot 48 in F. V. P. 227; in extent 2 roods and 37 perches, situated at Kahahengama in Kuruwiti korale, within the following boundaries:—

North, south and west by lot 55 in F. V. P. 227.

East by lot 233 in F. V. P. 227.

8. A portion of the bed of the stream called Gangulwitiyadola about 20 chains in length, situated at Gangulwitiya village in Nawadun korale, within the following boundaries, Section A to B:—

North by the remaining portion of Gangulwitiya-dola.

East by the right bank of Gangulwitiya-dola.

South by section B to C.

West by the left bank of Gangulwitiya-dola.

9. A portion of the bed of the stream called Gangulwitiya-dola about 20 chains in length, situated at Gangulwitiya village in Nawadun korale, within the following boundaries, Section B to C:—

North by section A to B.

East by the right bank of Gangulwitiya-dola.

South by the village limits of Batandeniya village.

West by the left bank of Gangulwitiya-dola.
