KEROSENE OIL.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph 2 of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,054 of December 21, 1942, I, Senarat Wije Goonewardane, Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Galle District, do, by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date the Order dated November 30, 1945, published in the *Government Gazette* No. 9,492 of December 7, 1945;
- (2) fix the prices for areas specified in column 1 of the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Schedules to be respectively, the maximum prices per four-gallon tin, the maximum price per gallon bulk and the maximum price per bottle specified in columns 3, 4 and 5 of the First, Second, and Third Schedules and columns 4 and 5 of the Fourth Schedule and column 5 of the Fifth Schedule referred to, above which Kerosene oil of the brands specified in column 2 of the Schedules hereto shall not be sold wholesale or by retail within the areas specified in column 1 of the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Schedules respectively;
- (3) direct that when four gallons or any multiple of four gallons of Kerosene oil of any description and grade specified in column 2 of the Schedules hereto are sold in four-gallon tins the maximum price to be charged for the same shall be determined by reference to the appropriate maximum price specified in column 3 of the respective Schedules hereto;
- (4) direct that every trader who exposes for sale Kerosene oil of the brands specified in column 2 of the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Schedules to this Order, at any premises or from a tank cart that hawks Kerosene oil for sale within the Galle District shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises on the tank cart that hawks Kerosene oil, for sale a notice in which shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of that article;
- (5) direct that no such trader or tank carter shall sell any Kerosene oil of any brand specified in column 2 of the Schedules hereto which is adulterated with any other article or any oil of an inferior description or quality;
- (6) direct that every person who sells by wholesale Kerosene oil of any brand specified in column 2 of the Schedules hereto shall, and any person who sells by retail shall on demand give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the brand of Kerosene oil sold;
 - (b) the quantity of Kerosene oil sold;
 - (c) the price paid;
 - (d) the date of sale.
- (7) direct that for the purpose of this Order a bottle shall be deemed to be one-sixth ($\frac{1}{6}$) of an Imperial gallon;
- (8) direct that sale of any quantity below one bottle shall be restricted to half bottle, three-quarter bottle, and quarter bottles, only, and sale of any intermediate quantity shall be prohibited;
- (9) direct that the price shall be calculated on the bottle rate in the case of sale by three-quarter, half or quarter bottles.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph 2 of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,054 of December 21, 1942, I, Dingiri Banda Mudannayake, Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Kandy District and Uda Hewaheta of Nuwara Eliya District, do, by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date Order dated October 18, 1945, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 9,483 of November 9, 1945;
- (2) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Second Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum price per gallon and the maximum price per bottle, above which Kerosene oil of the brands specified in the First Schedule hereto, shall not be sold by wholesale or by retail, within the respective areas mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto;
- (3) direct that every trader who exposes for sale any Kerosene oil of the brands specified in the First Schedule hereto at any premises within the areas mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of that article;
- (4) direct that no such trader shall sell any Kerosene oil of any brand specified in the First Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article or with any oil of an inferior description or quality;
- (5) direct that every person who sells Kerosene oil of any brand specified in the First Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of the Kerosene oil a receipt on which shall be set out—
 - (a) the brand of the Kerosene oil sold;
 - (b) the quantity of Kerosene oil sold;
 - (c) the price paid; and
 - (d) the date of the sale.
- (6) direct that for the purpose of this Order a "bottle" shall be deemed to be one-sixth (1/6) of an Imperial gallon;
- (7) direct that sale of any quantity below one bottle shall be restricted to half-bottle and quarter-bottle only. The sale of any intermediate quantity shall be prohibited;
- (8) direct that the price shall be calculated on the bottle rate in the case of sale by half or quarter bottles.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,054 of December 21, 1942, I, Joseph Percival Anthony Fernando, Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Matale, do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date Order dated September 25, 1945, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,468 of October 5, 1945, in respect of Kerosene oil for Matale District.
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum price per four gallon tin, the maximum price per gallon and the maximum price per bottle above which Kerosene oil specified in the Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the areas specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (iii.) direct that no trader, or tank carter who hawks Kerosene oil, shall sell any Kerosene oil specified in the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article or with any other oil of an inferior description or quality;
- (iv.) direct that every trader or tank carter who exposes for sale Kerosene oil specified in the Schedule hereto at any premises or from a tank cart that hawks Kerosene oil for sale within the areas mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises or on the tank cart that hawks Kerosene oil for sale a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this order for that article;
- (v.) direct that every person who sells by wholesale Kerosene oil specified in the Schedule hereto annexed and any

person who sells by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the quantity of Kerosene oil sold;
- (b) the price paid; and
- (c) the date and place of sale.

- (vi.) direct that for the purposes of this Order that a "bottle" shall be deemed to be one-sixth (1/6) of an Imperial gallon;
- (vii.) direct that sale of any quantity below one bottle shall be restricted to half bottle, three-quarter and one-quarter bottle only and the sale of any intermediate quantity shall be prohibited;
- (viii.) direct that the prices shall be calculated on the bottle rate in the case of sale by three-quarter, half or one-quarter bottle.
