THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) fix the prices specified in the Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per tube above which tubes of the description and grades specified in the Schedule hereto shall not be sold by retail in Ceylon ;
- (ii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order, any sale for the purpose of use, of any tube specified in the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;
- (iii.) direct that every trader, who at any premises in Ceylon, exhibits for sale tubes of the description and grades specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises the maximum prices fixed by this Order for tubes of that description and grade ;
- (iv.) direct that every person, who sells tubes of the description and grade specified in the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser of tubes a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the quantity, description, and grade of the tubes sold ;
 - (b) the price paid ; and
 - (c) the date and place of the sale.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) fix the prices specified in columns 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale and retail prices, respectively, above which lamps and

lanterns of the description, and make specified in columns 1 and 2, respectively, of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in Ceylon ;

- (ii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order, any sale for the purpose of use of any lamp or lantern of the description, and make specified in columns 1 and 2, respectively, of the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by retail and any sale for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale ;
- (iii.) direct that every person who at any premises in Ceylon exhibits for sale any lamp or lantern of the description and make specified in columns 1 and 2, respectively, of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed for such lamps or lanterns by this Order ;
- (iv.) direct that every person who sells any lamp or lantern of the description and make specified in columns 1 and 2, respectively, of the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser of such lamp or lantern on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the description, make and quantity of the lamps or lanterns sold ;
 - (b) the price paid ; and
 - (c) the date and place of sale.

TALCUM POWDER.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices respectively above which powder described in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold wholesale or retail respectively in Ceylon;
- (ii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of powder of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto to a wholesale dealer shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale by an importer;
 - (b) any sale for the purpose of resale of any quantity of powder of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (c) any sale for the purpose of use of any quantity of powder of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (d) "importer's maximum price" shall apply to any sale by an importer to a wholesale dealer;
 - (e) "maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale except sales by an importer to a wholesale dealer;
 - (f) "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail;
- (iii.) direct that every dealer, who at any premises in Ceylon exhibits for sale powder of the description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises the maximum prices fixed by this Order for Talcum Powder of that description;
- (iv.) direct that every person who sells powder of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall give to every purchaser of such powder, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the description and quantity of the powder sold;
 - (b) the price paid; and
 - (c) the date and place of the sale.

MILK FOODS.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulter, Controller of Prices (Food), do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date my Food Price Order No. C-63 published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,435 of July 20, 1945, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of Milk Food of the brands specified in the Schedule hereto;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price per case, and the maximum retail price per bottle above which the brand of milk food specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule and of the standard pack specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of that Schedule shall not be sold by wholesale or by retail, as the case may be, in any part of Ceylon.
- (iii.) direct that paragraphs (iii.) to (v.) of my Food Price Order No. C-63 relating to preserved milk and milk foods, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,435 of July 20, 1945, shall apply in the case of the milk food of the description named and specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto as though those paragraphs were incorporated in this Order.

MUSTARD.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulter, Controller of Prices (Food), do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date Food Price Order No. C-66, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,455 of August 31, 1945;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price per bushel and the maximum retail price per measure above which the article specified in

column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold by wholesale or by retail, as the case may be, within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo and within the revenue district of Anuradhapura ;

(iii.) direct for the purpose of this Order—

- (a) any sale of any quantity of any article for the purpose of resale or any sale of any article in a quantity of one bushel or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale ;
 (b) any sale of any quantity less than one bushel of any article for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;

(iv.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order no trader shall sell any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article or with an article of an inferior description or grade or quality ;

(v.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle any article specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the description of that article and the maximum prices fixed by this Order for that article in that area ;

(vi.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells by wholesale any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule

hereto shall, and every person who sells by retail any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule shall on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of sale ;
 (b) the description of the article sold ;
 (c) the volume of the quantity sold ;
 (d) the price paid for the quantity sold ;
 (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.
