GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS. PRICE ORDERS.

SOAP (LOCALLY MANUFACTURED).

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order:—

- (i.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the manufacturer's maximum price to a wholesale dealer per case, the maximum wholesale price per case, and the maximum retail price per tablet above which soap of the description specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold by wholesale or by retail, as the case may be, in any part of Ceylon;
- (ii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (c) "manufacturer" shall mean any person or firm or association of persons who manufactures any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule thereto;
 - (d) "wholesale dealer" shall mean any person who has been in the habit of selling for resale any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
 - (e) "manufacturer's maximum price" shall apply to any sale by wholesale by a manufacturer to a wholesale dealer;
 - (f) "maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale except sales by a manufacturer to a wholesale dealer;
 - (g) "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail;
- (iii.) direct that every trader who at any premises in Ceylon exhibits for sale any soap of the description specified in the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of soap of that description;
- (iv.) direct that every person who sells soap of the description mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of that soap a receipt, on demand, in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the quantity of soap sold;
 - (c) the description of soap sold;
 - (d) the price paid for the quantity of soap sold; and
 - (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (v.) direct that every trader who has at any time during the three months prior to this date sold any article mentioned in the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of that article available for sale shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises a notice to the effect that stocks of that article are not available for sale for the time being.

THREAD (LOCALLY MANUFACTURED).

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the manufacturer's maximum price (to a wholesale dealer), the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which thread of the description and grade specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (ii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any thread specified in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any thread specified in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iii.) direct that every person who sells any thread of the description and grade specified in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of such thread on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the quantity and description of the thread sold;
 - (b) the price paid; and
 - (c) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or retail;
- (iv.) direct that any trader who at any premises exhibits for sale any thread of the description and grade specified in the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of thread of that description and grade;
- (v.) direct that every trader, who has at any time during the three months prior to this date sold any thread specified in the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of that thread available for sale shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises a notice to the effect that stocks of that thread are not available for sale for the time being.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date—
 - (a) My order dated December 5, 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,342 of December 8, 1944, in so far as it relates to Dietz Junior lanterns;
 - (b) My order dated July 3, 1945, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,427 of July 6, 1945, in so far as it relates to Hurricane Lanterns marked "A. W. Sanderson & Co, 1945";
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale and retail prices, respectively, above which lamps and lanterns of the description, and make specified in columns 1 and 2, respectively, of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in Ceylon;

- (iv.) direct that every person who at any premises in Ceylon exhibits for sale any lamp or lantern of the description and make specified in columns 1 and 2, respectively, of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed for such lamps or lanterns by this Order;
- (v.) direct that every person who sells any lamp or lantern of the description and make specified in columns 1 and 2, respectively, of the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser of such lamp or lantern on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- (a) the description, make and quantity of the lamps or lanterns sold;
- (b) the price paid; and
- (c) the date and place of sale.
