#### THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE No. 39 OF 1939.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance No. 39 of 1939, as amended by the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Seemampillai Francis Chellappah, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) for the Island of Ceylon, do, by this Order—

- (i.) amend with effect from this date the Order dated February 13, 1945, published in *Gazette* No. 9,373 of February 23, 1945, as amended by any subsequent Order, by the omission from the Schedule to that Order of the items relating to the following drugs:—  
Ephedrine Hydrochloride tablets per 25 tablets by  $\frac{1}{2}$  (Genotasan, Ltd.)  
Milk of Magnesia (Phillips) 12 oz bottle.  
Nestrovite Emulsion per bottle.
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which drugs of the description specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (iii.) fix the quantity specified in column 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the minimum quantity of drugs of the description specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto which may be sold in any part of Ceylon; and
- (iv.) direct that clauses (d) to (h) of the Order dated February 13, 1945, published in *Gazette* No. 9,373 of February 23, 1945, as amended by any subsequent Order, shall apply to this Order as though those clauses were herein incorporated.

## THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 of 1939.

## Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated January 13, 1944, on Lux Flakes, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,228 of January 21, 1944;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in the Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices above which Lux Flakes of the description and size specified in the Schedule hereto shall not be sold by retail in any part of Ceylon;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order, any sale of any Lux Flakes specified in the Schedule hereto for the purposes of use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iv.) direct that every dealer, who at any premises in Ceylon sells Lux Flakes of the description and size specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises the maximum prices fixed by this Order for Lux Flakes of that description and size;
- (v.) direct that every person who sells any Lux Flakes of the description and size specified in the Schedule hereto shall give to every purchaser of such Lux Flakes a receipt, on demand, in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the quantity, description and size of Lux Flakes sold;
  - (b) the price paid; and
  - (c) the date of sale.

## THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 of 1939.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,054 of December 21, 1942, I, Danister Priyalal Wickramasuriya, Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Matara District, do, by this Order—

- (i.) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices above which cement of the description mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 shall not be sold anywhere in Matara District;
- (ii.) direct that every trader who at any premises in Matara District, exhibit for sale any cement of the description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of cement of that description;
- (iii.) direct that every person who sells cement of the description in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of that cement, a receipt, on demand, in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the quantity of the cement sold (by weight),
  - (b) description of cement sold,
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity of cement sold,
  - (d) the date of sale.
