#### PRICE ORDERS.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

### KEROSENE OIL.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) by section 3 read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Samuel Cyrus Jesudason, Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Badulla District, do, by this Order:—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date my Order published in the Government Gazette No. 9,501 of January 4, 1946, in so far as it relates to the maximum price of kerosene oil fixed for the Province of Uva;
- (2) fix the prices specified in columns 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the agent's maximum price per gallon aw depot, the maximum retail price per gallon and the retail price per bottle, above which kerosene oil of the brands specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the corresponding area specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (3) direct that the maximum price which may be demanded by any person for any quantity of kerosene oil which is more or less than one gallon or one bottle, as the case may be, shall be determined by reference to the appropriate maximum price per gallon or bottle fixed by this Order;
- (4) direct that any person who exposes for sale any kerosene oil of any, brand specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous place at those premises, a notice, on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order of that, brand of kerosene oil;
- (5) direct that no person shall sell any kerosene oil of any brand specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other oil of an inferior description or quality;
- (6) direct that every person who sells any kerosene oil of any brand specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto shall on demand give the purchaser of that kerosene oil a receipt on which shall be set out-
  - (a) the quantity of kerosene oil sold;
  - (b) the price paid; (c) the date of sale;
- (7) direct that for the purpose of this order a bottle shall be deemed to be one-sixth (1/6) of an imperial gallon;
- (8) direct that the sale of any quantity below one bottle shall be restricted to half bottle and quarter bottle only intermediate quantity shall be prohibited and the price shall be calculated on the bottle rate in the case of sale by half or quarter or bottle.

## THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 of 1939.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Seemampillai Francis Chellappah, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) for the Island of Ceylon, do by this Order-

- (i) amond with effect from this date the Order dated February 13, 1945, published in Gazette No. 9,373 of February 23, 1945, as amended by any subsequent Order, by the omission from the Schedule to that Order of the items relating to the following drugs:-
  - F.C.V.D. (Crookes) per bottle. Zambuk per small tin.
- (ii) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which drugs of the description specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (iii) fix the quantity in column 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the minimum quantity of drugs of the description specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule heroto which may be sold in any part of Coylon; and
- (iv) direct that clauses (d) to (h) of the Order dated February 13, 1945, published in Gazette No. 9,373 of February 23, 1945, as amended by any subsequent Order, shall apply to this Order as though those clauses were herein incorporated

FRESH FISH.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

# Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Allan Basil Samuel Nesarajah Pullenayegum, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) for the Island, do by this Order-

- . (i.) revoke with effect from this date Food Price Order No. C-87, published in Government Gazette No. 9,526 of March 1. 1946, in so far as it fixes maximum prices above which Fresh Fish shall not be sold in the Revenue District of Mannar:
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in column 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices above which fresh fish of the description specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the area specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (iii.) direct that for the purposes of this Order-

  - (a) "Big Fish" shall mean fish each weighing 1½ lb. or more with head, tail, gut and fins;
    (b) "Small Fish" shall mean fish each weighing less than 1½ lb. with head, tail, gut and fins;
    (c) "Fresh Fish" shall mean all fish other than dried fish, tinned fish, shell fish and fish cured by brine or by any other process;
- (iv.) direct that when big fish is sold with head, tail, gut, or fins no extra charge shall be made for such head, tail, gut, or fins; provided, however, that the head, tail, gut or fins, when sold alone, may be charged for;
- (v.) direct that every trader, who at any premises within the areas specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto has in his possession any fresh fish of the description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of that fresh fish;
- (vi.) direct that every person who sells any fresh fish of the description specified in the Schedule hereto shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in wheih there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of sale;
  - (b) the description of the fish sold;
  - (c) the weight of the fish sold; and
  - (d) the price paid for the quantity sold.
