DISEASES ORDINANCE.

Notification.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 1 of the regulations under sections 2 and 3 of the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance (Chapter 173), published in the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 7,481 of August 28, 1925, I, Henry Monck-Mason Moore, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Notification confirm the declaration of the "diseased locality" specified in the Schedule hereto, made by the Government Agent, Western Province, the proper authority in that behalf, on January 23, 1946.
