THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASES
ORDINANCE.

Notification.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 1 of the regulations under sections 2 and 3 of the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance (Chapter 173), published in the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 7,481 of August 28, 1925, I, Henry Monck-Mason Moore, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Notification confirm the declaration of the "diseased locality" specified in the Schedule hereto, made by the Chairman of the Kolonnawa Urban Council, the proper authority in that behalf, on January 29, 1946.

Schedule.

The following area within the Kolonnawa Urban Council limits:—

North—That portion to the South of Pansalahena Road, Meetotamulla and Perera Avenue.

East—Portion to the West of Pansalahena Road and Pansala Road.

West—Weraluwatota Ela, bordering Municipal limits adjoining Dematagoda area.

South—Portion to the North of Kolonnawa Road from the bridge bordering Municipal limits at Dematagoda as far as Pansala Road; and the whole of the Colombo Port Commission Premises.
