THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASES ORDINANCE.

Notification.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by regulation 1 of the regulations under sections 2 and 3 of the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance (Chapter 173), published in the Supplement to Gazette No. 7,481 of August 28, 1925, I, Robert Harry Drayton, Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon, do by this Notification confirm the declaration of the "diseased locality" specified in the Schedule hereto made by the Assistant

Government Agent, Kalutara, the proper authority in that behalf, on April 10, 1946.

The portion of the village of Ingiriya in Raigam Korale of the Kalutara District and bounded as follows:—

North: by Rada Ela;
East: by Government Road Reservation and Hikgasgoda;
South: by Galkanda Tea Estate, tract of fields called
Galpotte Kumburuyaya, and Phobeland Estate; and

West: by Ingiriya Ela.
