The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

M.L.A.—BA 649.

An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Councils Ordinance.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils (Amendment) Ordinance, No. $\,$ of 194 $\,$.

2. Section 43 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance is hereby amended in sub-section (1) of that section, by the substitution in paragraph (f) of that sub-section, for the words "and planting trees in streets;", of the words "planting trees in streets; and the erection and maintenance of shelters in streets for the use of passengers by omnibus;".

Objects and Reasons.

Representations have, from time to time, been made to the Colombo Municipal Council to the effect that the Council should provide shelters in streets for the convenience of passengers who travel by omnibus. The Council has, however, been unable to do so as section 43 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance (Chapter 193) does not enable the Municipal Council to expend funds for the purpose of erecting and maintaining such shelters. The object of this Bill is to amend that section so as to enable Municipal Councils to expend funds for that purpose.
