PRICE ORDERS.

CEMENT.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date Orders—
 - (a) dated August 8, 1942, on Cement (Indian) published in *Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,986 of August 13, 1942,
 - (b) dated May 24, 1943, on Cement (English) published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,126 of May 28, 1943;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices above which cement of the description mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo;
- (iii.) direct that every trader, who at any premises within the Municipal limits of Colombo, exhibits for sale any cement of the description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at

those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of cement of that description;

- (iv.) direct that every person who sells cement of the description mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of that cement a receipt, on demand, in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the quantity of the cement sold (by weight),
- (b) description of cement sold,
- (c) the price paid for the quantity of cement sold, and
- (d) the date of sale.
