ORDER made by the Officer Administering the Government by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 14 of the Defence Force Ordinance (Chapter 258).

Rates of pay for members of the Ceylon Post and Telegraph Signals Corps.

1. Officers and other ranks of Category A will be entitled to the scales of pay laid down for officers and other ranks of the other Corps of the Ceylon Defence Force, and under the same conditions.

2. (a) Officers and other ranks of Category B will continue to receive their civil salary together with service pay referred to in sub-paragraph (b).

(b) Service pay shall be computed on the basis of the civil salary according to the following scale of percentages:—

| In the case of the 1st unit of 50 rupees or any part thereof . . . | 25 per cent. of that unit or part |
| In the case of the 2nd unit of 50 rupees or any part thereof . . . | 20 per cent. of that unit or part |

| In the case of the 4th unit of 50 rupees or any part thereof . . . | 10 per cent. of that unit or part |
| In the case of the 5th unit of 50 rupees or any part thereof . . . | 5 per cent. of that unit or part |
| In the case of the 6th unit and subsequent units or parts thereof . . . | Nil |

(c) Officers and other ranks shall not be entitled to earn overtime under the Public Service Regulations while they are on full time military duty.

(d) Overtime or civil or military allowances shall not be taken into account in computing service pay.

(e) "Ordinary pay" for purposes of the Army Act, King's Regulations, and other Regulations, is defined as civil salary (exclusive of overtime, bonus, or civil or military allowances) plus service pay.

(f) "Day's pay", in the case of members in receipt of ordinary pay on a monthly basis, is defined as one-thirtieth of the ordinary pay for one month.

3. Followers will be entitled to the scales of pay laid down for followers of the Ceylon Engineers, and under the same conditions.

4. In this Order—

"Officers and other ranks of Category A" means Officers and other ranks who are not employees of the Post and Telegraph Department; and

"Officers and other ranks of Category B" means Officers and other ranks who are employees of the Post and Telegraph Department.

2. Any dog found in any public place or road, or any other place other than a private building, compound or garden within the limits of the said district, and not being tied up or led is liable to be destroyed forthwith.

3. This proclamation will be in force for a period of six months from September 1, 1946.

Internal Purchase Scheme.**Harvesting of Paddy in Anuradhapura District, 1946 Yala Season.**

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations, the Defence (Purchase of Food-stuffs) Regulations 1942, and the Defence (Paddy Cultivation) Regulations, 1943, I do hereby direct that:—

(1) No cultivator, shareholder or other person shall remove from the threshing floor any paddy harvested in the 1946 Yala Season from any field in the Nuwarakalaviya District, until a record of the paddy gathered has been taken by the village headman or any other person authorised by me in writing.

(2) Removal thereafter to the barn or other place of storage within Nuwarakalaviya District shall only be on permits on form I. P. S., 33 or I. P. S. 33A, issued by the Vel Vidane, the Village Headman or other authorised person of the area in which the threshing floor is situated.

(3) Removal to places outside the District shall only be on permits issued by me. Non-residents who desire to remove their shares of paddy allowed for consumption to places outside Nuwarakalaviya should make their applications on form D. F. C., 34, in duplicate, to the Revenue Officer or the Assistant Government Agent, (E) of the area in which they reside.

(4) The Paddy due to Government as acreage levy, *i.e.*, One bushel per acre during the Yala Season, shall be delivered at the threshing floor to the Vel Vidane, Village Headman or other person authorised to purchase paddy under the Internal Purchase Scheme.

(5) Owners and cultivators shall give three clear days notice of their intention to harvest and to thresh any paddy to the Vel Vidane, Village headman or other person appointed by me to assess the crop.

MOTOR CAR ORDINANCE, No. 45 OF 1938.

List of Applications for Licences for Lorries, for 1946.

IN terms of section 46 of the Motor Car Ordinance, No. 45 of 1938, a list of applications for licences for lorries for the rest of the year, 1946, is published below for general information.

The following extract from the Ordinance applies to objections against the issue of licences, &c. :—

" 46 (2). (a) Any licensing authority, within whose area any part of the area of operation proposed by any applicant for a licence for a lorry is situated, may make objection against the issue of that licence. (b) Any person who is the holder of a valid licence, or who is himself an applicant for a licence, for a lorry in respect of the whole or any part of the area of operation which is proposed by any other applicant may on payment of the prescribed fee, make objection against the issue of the licence to such other person.

46 (4). Any person, who is entitled under sub-section (2) to make objection to the issue of any licence, may, on payment of the prescribed fee *, inspect the application for that licence at any reasonable time at the Office of the Commissioner. Provided, however, that no fee shall be payable by any licensing authority in respect of any application."

Objections must be made in the manner stated below to the Commissioner of Motor Transport, Colombo, so as to be received by him not later than 2 P.M., ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 1946.

1. Every objection in respect of an application for a licence for a lorry shall be made by a written statement on good and suitable paper which shall be signed by the person making the objection. Where the objection is made by any body corporate or firm, it shall be signed by a person duly authorized in that behalf by such body or partner of the firm, as the case may be.

2. Every objection shall be made in duplicate and the original shall, where the objection is made by any person other than a licensing authority, bear stamps (uncancelled) to the value of Rs. 2.50.

3. Every statement of objection shall set out the specific grounds on which the objection is based and shall indicate, by reference to the name of the applicant, for the licence and to the distinctive number of the motor car, the application in respect of which the objection is made.

4. No objection relating to more than one motor car shall be made in any one statement of objection. Any objections not conforming to these requirements will be of no avail. Objectors under section 46 (2) are requested to state clearly in their objections the facts entitling them to object, *i.e.*, whether they are holders of valid licences or are themselves applicants for licences for lorries in respect of the whole or any part of the area of operation and additional services proposed by any applicant. They are also requested to give the registered number of their vehicles in the area applied for or cite the serial number of their applications as listed in the *Gazette*.

If the objection is in respect of any application for a lorry, "under construction" the serial number given to the application in the list should be quoted.
