#### GENERAL CLERICAL SERVICE EXAMINATION.

##### Date of Examination—

1. A competitive examination for male candidates wishing to enter the General Clerical Class of the General Clerical Service, will be held in Colombo, Kandy, Galle and Jaffna, on January 25, 1947.

2. (i.) *Salary*.—Successful candidates will be appointed to the General Clerical Class of the General Clerical Service on the salary of Rs. 840 per annum rising by annual increments of Rs. 72 to Rs. 2,424 per annum. In this scale efficiency bars operate before Rs. 1,488 and Rs. 2,064 per annum.

(ii.) *Conditions of Service*.—(a) The grant of leave and other conditions will in the case of a new entrant to the Public Service be governed by the recommendations in Sessional Paper VIII. of 1934 as modified by the recommendations in Sessional Paper VIII. of 1946. Rent allowance will be payable.

(b) Successful candidates will be appointed on 2 years' probation. They will be liable to transfer and may be posted to any station in Ceylon. They will be required to pass a test in typewriting within one year of the date of appointment and no increment of salary will be given until the test is passed. They will be subject to the Public Service, Financial and other Standing Regulations of the Government.

(c) Successful candidates with previous continuous service under Government may be allowed incremental credit for such service. Assistant Clerks will be given a salary conversion under F. R. 847.

3. The names of successful candidates will be published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette*, and they will be given appointments as suitable vacancies occur.

##### Eligibility—

4. (i.) Candidates must be of good character.
- (ii.) Candidates must be Ceylonese\*.
- (iii.) Candidates should have previously passed at least—
  - (a) The Cambridge Senior or the London Matriculation, or the Ceylon Senior School Certificate (English) Examination; or
  - (b) The Final Examination for the Commercial Certificate of the Ceylon Technical College; or
  - (c) One of the following Junior examinations:—

The Cambridge Junior, the Junior School Certificate (English) Examination of the Education Department, Ceylon, or the Junior School Certificate (English) Examination held by a school approved by the Education Department for the Senior School Certificate (English) Examination.

together with either (i.) the Higher Commercial Certificate Examination (either section) of the London Chamber of Commerce or (ii.) the Commercial Certificate Examination (either section) of the London Chamber of Commerce.

(iv.) Candidates must be within the age limits laid down in paragraph 6.(iv.).

5. Clerks in the Assistant Clerks' Service controlled by the Deputy Chief Secretary will be permitted to sit for the examination provided they are not more than 25 years of age on August 1, 1947, and provided they possess the educational qualifications prescribed in paragraph 4 (iii.) (a), (b) or (c) above.

*Applications—*

6. (1) Applications for admission to the examination must be addressed to the Director of Education (Branch E) on forms which may be obtained from the Inquiry Office, Education Department, up to November 13, 1946.

Applications must be sent by registered post to reach the Director of Education (Branch E) not later than 2 P.M. on November 20, 1946. Any applications received after that hour will be rejected.

(ii.) Candidates who are already employed in Government Departments, whether in a permanent or temporary capacity, must forward their applications through the Heads of the Departments in which they are serving. If any candidate fails to do so, he will be regarded as disqualified.

(iii.) Stamps to the value of Rs. 10 must be affixed to each application and cancelled by the candidate's signature over them.

(iv.) A certificate of the registration of the candidate's birth showing him to be born not earlier than August 1, 1925, and not later than August 1, 1930, must be attached to the form of application.

*N.B.—The maximum age limit in future examinations for recruitment to the General Clerical Class will be 21 years.*

*Note.—(a) Certificates of birth issued for the purpose of the Code for Assisted Schools will not be accepted for this examination.*

*(b) Affidavits will not be accepted as substitutes for birth certificates.*

*(c) A certified copy of a birth registration entry effected more than one year after the date of the birth, under section 18 (1) (b) of the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance (Cap. 94), will be accepted only after consideration of the evidence by which the date of birth was established. Where the name appearing in the birth certificate differs from the name which the candidate ordinarily uses, satisfactory evidence will have to be adduced that the birth certificate is that of the candidate and not that of any other person. Where the candidate is under 21 years of age or is more than 21 years of age and has a parent living, application should be made to the Registrar-General's or to the Provincial Registrar's or Assistant Provincial Registrar's Office in the district in which the birth took place under section 19 of the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance for the amendment of the entry in case 2 of the birth registration entry, and in other cases application should be made to the District Court under section 20 for rectification of the entry in case 2.*

*(v.) A certificate of good character signed by a responsible person to the satisfaction of the Director of Education must also be attached to the form of application. If the candidate has been educated at a Government or Assisted School, the certificate of character must be from the Principal of the last Government or Assisted School which he has attended; otherwise it may be from the candidate's teacher or schoolmaster by preference or a member of the Public Service, a Justice of the Peace, Minister of Religion, Advocate, Proctor or Notary, or generally speaking, some person whose name is known and to whom reference can be readily made.*

*(vi.) The Director of Education will issue admission forms to those candidates whose applications are accepted. Candidates presenting themselves for examination must produce to the officer appointed to supervise the examination their forms of admission. A candidate not producing such form will be refused admittance to the examination.*

Candidates must sit for the examination at the Examination Hall assigned to them. A candidate presenting himself at an Examination Hall other than the one assigned to him will be refused admission to the examination.

A copy of the Time Table and the Rules for the guidance of candidates for the Examination will be forwarded together with the admission form. These should be read carefully by candidates. Every candidate presenting himself for the examination must give up his admission form to the Supervising Examiner on the day of the examination.

If a candidate does not receive his admission form at least seven days before the day of the examination he should communicate without delay with the Director of Education (Branch E), Education Department, informing him that he has not received the admission form and giving the following information:—

7. Clerks on the permanent establishment of Government Departments who are paid directly from "Personal Emoluments" Votes in the Government Estimates (other than members of the Customs, Postal, Survey, Printing, Harbour Engineer's or Railway Departments, Draughtsmen, and Stenographers), if within the age prescribed in these regulations will be admitted without fee provided that they have passed the examination or examinations prescribed by regulation 4 (iii.) above and that their services since employment under Government have been throughout satisfactory.

8. Should any of the particulars furnished by candidates be found to be false within their knowledge, they will, if appointed, be liable to be dismissed. The wilful suppression of any material fact will be similarly penalised.

*Withdrawals and Refunds—*

9. (a) If a candidate is rejected owing to his not satisfying the conditions for admission to the examination a refund will be made of 3/5ths the value of stamps affixed to his application.

(b) If a candidate, who has been admitted to the examination gives notice of his withdrawal to the Director of Education at least 14 days before the date of the examination, a refund will be made of half the value of stamps affixed to his application. In case the form of admission to the examination has reached the candidate it should be returned to the Director of Education (Branch E) for the refund to be made.

(c) A candidate, who has been admitted to the examination and wishes to withdraw on account of illness, should forward notice of his withdrawal together with his admission form to the Director of Education (Branch E), by registered post at least one day before the examination. A refund of the full value of stamps affixed to his application will then be made, provided his notice of withdrawal is accompanied by a certificate from a qualified medical practitioner to the effect that he is unfit to sit for the examination.

(d) In no other case will a refund be granted.

*Leave to Government Officers to attend Examination—*

10. Heads of Departments are required to grant to officers of their Departments whose applications have been approved by the Director of Education, leave to present themselves at the examination.

Sinhalese must be taken by Sinhalese candidates and Tamil by Tamil candidates. Candidates who are neither Sinhalese nor Tamil will be given the option of taking Sinhalese or Tamil or Arabic or a Special Paper in English but candidates of mixed parentage must offer the language of one of their parents within the group English (Special), Sinhalese, Tamil or Arabic.

(4) *Viva Voce Test*—Candidates are required to produce at the Viva Voce test the original certificates granted to them in respect of the examinations they have passed which qualify them for admission to the General Clerical Service Examination .. .. . 100

12. The examination is held in two parts. The written examination is first held and on the results of it candidates are selected competitively to attend the Viva Voce. The number to be called for the Viva Voce examination will be fixed by the Deputy Chief Secretary in consultation with the Director of Education. In all written papers marks will be deducted for bad writing and mistakes in spelling. Candidates whose writing is illegible are liable to be disqualified. The Viva Voce examination will be held in Colombo.

*Medical Examination—*

13. The successful candidates will be required to pass a medical examination as to their physical fitness for service in any part of the Island.

The Rules for Passenger and Goods Train Traffic and Rates and Classification of Goods published in the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 7,514 of February 26, 1926, as last amended by rule published in *Gazette* No. 9,412 of June 1, 1945, are hereby further amended as follows:—

1. Under the heading "Parcels", in rule 34, by the substitution, in paragraph (d), for all the words from "All Parcels" to "1 cwt.", of the following:—

"(d) All parcels left in the railway premises beyond a period of 48 hours after their arrival will be subject to a cloakroom charge of 10 cents per package per day or part of a day after such period, subject to the following exceptions:—

(i) consignees residing more than two miles and not exceeding ten miles from the railway station will be allowed free storage for 60 hours;

(ii) consignees residing more than ten miles from the railway station will be allowed free storage for 72 hours.

In computing cloakroom charges on parcels, Sundays shall be excluded, except that in the case of parcels tendered for despatch or taken delivery of on a Sunday, such Sunday shall be reckoned in the same way as any other day."

2. Under the heading "Left Luggage", in rule 61, by the substitution, for paragraph (a), of the following new paragraph:—

"(a) The Government are not responsible for any luggage or articles left by passengers at the station whether in charge of the station staff or not, unless these be duly registered, for which a charge of 15 cents per article is made, payable at the time of deposit. An additional charge of 10 cents per day, or part of a day, is made on every article left in the cloakroom for a longer period than two days, the day of deposit and the day of removal each counting as one day. Bicycles, tricycles, perambulators, bath chairs and other similar vehicles which are not mechanically propelled, are charged 35 cents each, and a further charge of 15 cents per day in addition is made on all such articles remaining in the cloakroom longer than two days";

3. Under the heading "Horses, Carriages, Dogs, Motors, &c." in rule 51 in paragraph (b)—

(1) by the deletion in the item relating to motor bicycles and motor scooters, of the words "and motor scooters"; and

(2) by the insertion, immediately after the item dealing with motor tricycles or motor bicycles with fore-carriage or side car, of the following new item:—

"Auto-cycles and motor scooters, each 05."

4. Under the heading "Conveyance of Goods Traffic"—  
(1) in rule 14, by the insertion, at the end thereof, of the following words:—

"On Sunday, Good Friday, Hindu New Year's Day, the full moon day of the Sinhalese month Wesak, Christmas Day and the first week-day next following, goods sheds and offices are entirely closed, but arrangements exist for the delivery of perishable goods and live stock."

(2) in rule 22—

(a) by the substitution for paragraph (a), of the following new paragraph:—

"22. Warehouse Rent.—(a) All goods left in the Railway premises beyond 20 working hours after their arrival will be subject to a rent charge of 10 cents per cwt. per diem after such period, with a minimum charge as for 1 cwt. and as for 1 day, subject to the following exceptions:—

(1) Consignees residing more than 2 miles and not exceeding 10 miles from the railway station will be allowed free storage for 30 working hours from the time of arrival of goods.

(2) Consignees residing more than 10 miles from the railway station will be allowed free storage for 40 working hours from the time of arrival of goods."

(b) by the insertion, at the end of paragraph (c), of the following words:—

"Sunday, Good Friday, Hindu New Year's Day, the full moon day of the Sinhalese month Wesak, Christmas Day and the first week-day next following, will be considered as dies non."

TRADE DISPUTE—MESSRS. CARGILLS, LTD.,  
COLOMBO.

THE Ceylon Mercantile Union, Colombo, presented a petition to me under section 6 (1) of the Essential Services (Avoidance of Strikes and Lockouts) Order, 1942, with regard to a trade dispute that had arisen between the said Union and Messrs. Cargills, Ltd., Colombo. The petition was referred to a Special Tribunal appointed by His Excellency the Governor under the proviso to section 5 of the said Order for adjudication.

The following award entered in terms of an agreement arrived at between the parties is published for general information in terms of section 8 (4) of the above-mentioned Order:—

“I am informed that agreements have been arrived at between the parties with regard to the grading of the various types of employees employed by the respondent Company. Agreements have also been arrived at with regard to the salary scales to be paid to the various clerks, salesmen and other employees; and also agreements have been arrived at with regard to the salaries now to be paid to the various employees who are at present employed. These salaries include also the salary to be paid to the technical employees employed in the Radio Department, Cycle Repair Department and other mechanics who are receiving daily rates of pay.

A document embodying the grading of the various employees, the salary scales for the various grades and the salaries fixed for the various individuals, who are at present employed, together with the cost of living allowance, is handed in to me. The document is filed of record, marked X\*. In terms of the agreement arrived at between the parties, I award that the grading of the various employees employed by the respondent Company should be as set out on the first page of X\*. The salaries assigned to the various grades would be as set out on page 2\*. The salaries to be paid to the various employees who are at present employed will be as set out on page 4\* and the following pages up to 18\*. The agreement also embodies certain conditions as set out in the footnotes at pages 2 and 3\*. These agreements also will form part of the award.

It is also agreed and understood between the parties that if any clerk or other employee is at present receiving a salary higher than the maximum salary assigned to his grade, he will continue to receive that salary, and he will also be deemed to have been considered efficient enough for promotion to the next higher grade and he will continue to receive his increments assigned for that higher grade.

I also note that with regard to stenographers, the Commercial Education Certificate Examination, which was conducted by the Ceylon Technical College, is at present not being conducted, enabling external students to take up that examination. It therefore becomes necessary to substitute in place of the Commercial Education Certificate Examination conducted by the Ceylon Technical College, a comparable examination which is conducted by the London Chamber of Commerce and which is held in Ceylon for external students. A stenographer, who is qualified by passing the higher Commercial Examination of the London Chamber of Commerce will be entitled to be promoted and to draw his salary as provided for the higher clerical grade, which takes him to the maximum of Rs. 250.

It is also agreed that if as a result of the coming into operation of this award, any employee becomes entitled to draw salaries or wages provided for the various employees referred to in this award on a higher scale than he is at present receiving, any arrears of salaries or wages due to him would become payable as if this award had been in operation on and after April 1, 1946.

As regards leave privileges, the respondent Company is bound by the provisions of the Shops Ordinance, and the employees will be awarded leave privileges as provided in that Ordinance. I am informed by the Managing Director of the respondent Company that in addition to the leave provided for under the Shops Ordinance, an employee, who is forced to be absent from work on the ground of illness, of which proof is furnished, is given full-pay leave, and in some cases half-pay leave in the case of prolonged illness. I understand

the Company is prepared to continue to do this, and I therefore, allow the matter to rest there without making any further award.

As regards Provident Fund, I am informed that as from April 1, 1946, when the new Company was formed, a Provident Fund has been inaugurated on the basis that during the first ten years of service the employer and the employee each contributes 5 per cent. of the employee's salary per month towards this Fund. During the next ten years the percentage of contribution by the employer and employee is 7½ per cent. and for the remainder of the service the percentage of contribution by employer and employee is 10 per cent. I accordingly award that the Provident Fund on the terms set out above should be continued for the benefit of the employees.

In view of the existence of this Provident Fund, which I have awarded, it is understood that the employer is not bound to inaugurate a scheme for the payment of pensions as well; nor could the employees demand that such a scheme should be started in addition to the Provident Fund Scheme.

With regard to the legacy of £1,000 sterling as provided in the Will of Alice May Jenkins, an extract from which Will is produced marked R 1\*, I find that this legacy was specifically left to the Auxiliary Staff Provident Fund of Cargills, Limited. Only members of the staff, who are members of this Auxiliary Staff Provident Fund (now known as the No. 2 Reserve) would, therefore, benefit by this legacy. I accordingly award that this sum of money should be paid only to the persons who are entitled to share in it by reason of the fact that they were members of the Auxiliary Staff Provident Fund (now known as the No. 2 Reserve).”

Co., LTD., NAWALAPITIYA.

THE Lanka Motor Workers' Union, Kandy, presented a petition to me under Section 6 (1) of the Essential Services (Avoidance of Strikes and Lockouts) Order, 1942, with regard to a trade dispute that had arisen between the said Union and Messrs. Madhyama Lanka Bus Co., Ltd., Nawalapitiya. The petition was referred by me to the District Judge, Kandy, under Section 6 (2) of the said Order for adjudication.

The following Order dated September 26, 1946, made by the District Judge, Kandy, is published for general information in terms of section 8 (4) of the above-mentioned Order:—

“The petitioner Union has submitted a petition to the Commissioner of Labour which petition has been referred to this Court for decision. The Commissioner of Labour whilst forwarding this petition has stated that he was satisfied that the petition related to a trade dispute.

The matter comes up under the Essential Services (Avoidance of Strikes and Lockouts) Order, 1942. The matter arises on a dismissal of one of the employees of the Defendant Company, which Company is a Limited Liability Company, having as many as 35 buses.

Karunadasa, who has given evidence for the petitioner, has stated that he was one of the conductors employed by this Company. He also admits that he was a daily-paid worker, paid Re. 1.90 a day. In law a daily-paid worker is not entitled to a month's notice before his services are discontinued. He works from day to day and can demand payment of his daily wages. Karunadasa admits that a checkroll is kept in which the presence and absence of these daily workers were entered. No doubt their remuneration or wages were paid at the end of the month. That does not alter the nature of the service.

The question for consideration in this inquiry is whether the respondent Company was justified in discontinuing the services of Karunadasa. I think Karunadasa's own admission in the witness box fully justified his dismissal. He on his own admission has had a very bad record. He has been misappropriating collections. For instance, on one occasion when one Mr. Amarasinghe travelled in the bus carrying certain bags of paddy, Rs. 13.70 was charged from him. Karunadasa had to issue tickets to passengers for fares paid by them and for the luggage carried. These ticket books are kept in foil and counterfoil. The counterfoil is kept in the ticket book and the foil is issued to the passenger. What is entered in the foil must tally with what is entered in the counterfoil. In the case of Amarasinghe, the foil which is produced marked R1\*, shows that Rs. 13.70 had been recovered from him by way of fare. Karunadasa admits that in the corresponding counterfoil the amount entered was Re. 1.70. He admits that Rs. 13.70 was actually recovered from Amarasinghe and that money went to his pocket; but when accounting in the evening for the collections, he only

accounted for Re. 1.70 and, to support that position, he had made a wrong entry in the counterfoil that only Re. 1.70 was recovered from Amarasinghe, so that Karunadasa had misappropriated a sum of Rs. 12 in that particular instance. Karunadasa has admitted the various occasions that he had been found fault with by the General Manager, Mr. Dias, and the fines that had been inflicted on him.

I think this Bus Company has been far too tolerant of this particular conductor. It was that tolerance spread over a long period that has emboldened Karunadasa and, thereafter, he persisted in being dishonest.

On March 29, 1946, Karunadasa admits that he was conductor of one of the buses which plied between Kotiyagala and Hatton. To go to Kotiyagala from Hatton the bus had to pass Norwood, which is the junction. From Norwood a road branches off towards Maskeliya, and one road branches towards Kotiyagala, so that, whether you come from Kotiyagala or from Maskeliya, one has to pass Norwood to go to Hatton. Karunadasa admits that some pilgrims, twelve in number, got into the bus before he reached Norwood from Hatton, and that they travelled about one-eighth of a mile. Thereafter they were told that the bus will not go to Maskeliya. Then the passengers got down. But the respondent Company states that Karunadasa actually allowed these passengers to travel six miles, that is to say, from Hatton to Norwood, and had charged them one rupee each. He had taken them under false pretences. He had promised to take them to Maskeliya, whereas the bus was not going to Maskeliya at all. At Norwood the people were made to get down in the rain. They complained to Mr. Silva, the Chairman of the Board of Directors, who was a well known gentleman, and who happened to be in one of his boutiques in that bazaar at that time.

Karunadasa admits that Mr. Silva sent for him and questioned him. Karunadasa also admits that one of the bus inspectors, namely, Silva, was also questioned by Mr. Silva. This happened on March 29, 1946. Karunadasa's services were suspended on March 29, 1946, after inquiry by the General Manager, Mr. Dias. On April 16, 1946, Karunadasa wrote to the General Manager—*vide* letter R 3\*. In this letter he admits that the passengers travelled in the bus, but he says that they travelled for only about  $\frac{1}{4}$ th of a mile.

Mr. Dias, the General Manager, has been very fair to this man. Having been satisfied on the evidence that Karunadasa had misappropriated a certain sum of money, he took no action beyond suspending the man but reported the matter to the Board of Directors to give the man a further chance if the Board of Directors decided in his favour, but the Board of Directors have decided otherwise.

I hold on this evidence that Karunadasa had been guilty of misconduct in that he collected money from passengers without issuing tickets on March 29, 1946, and misappropriated same. He is a daily-paid worker. The respondent Company is fully justified in discontinuing the services of an employee who has been found guilty of misconduct.

The application is dismissed. The petitioner Union will pay the respondent Company the costs of this inquiry which I fix at Rs. 31.50."

TRADE DISPUTE—COLOMBO-RATNAPURA OMNIBUS CO., LTD.,  
COLOMBO.

THE All Ceylon Motor Transport Workers' Union, Colombo, presented a petition to me under Section 6 (1) of the Essential Services (Avoidance of Strikes and Lockouts) Order, 1942, with regard to a trade dispute that had arisen between the said Union and Messrs. Colombo-Ratnapura Omnibus Co., Ltd., Colombo. The petition was referred by me to the District Judge, Colombo, under Section 6 (2) of the said Order for adjudication.

The following Order dated September 27, 1946, made by the District Judge, Colombo, is published for general information in terms of Section 8 (4) of the above-mentioned Order:—

"This matter arises out of a petition presented by the Joint Secretary of the All Ceylon Motor Transport Workers' Union to the Commissioner of Labour, Colombo, against the Colombo-Ratnapura Omnibus Co., Ltd., on behalf of 14 persons who were stated to be members of the Union, detailing the grievances of these 14 persons and praying that they be reinstated and paid their salaries for the period that they were out of work. The Commissioner of Labour has referred this matter for settlement to this Tribunal.

The 14 petitioners fall into two categories as stated by Dr. N. M. Perera, who appeared for them. Three out of the

14 were bus conductors who were discontinued from service under the respondent company before the motor workers' strike on November 21, 1945. The balance 11 were discontinued as a result of this strike of November 21, 1945, according to the petitioners.

I will first dispose of the case for the 3 conductors who were discontinued from the service of the respondent company prior to the strike. There can be no doubt on the evidence, both oral and documentary, that these three persons were found to be dishonest and they had misappropriated money belonging to the company by not issuing tickets to all the passengers that travelled in the Company's buses. The book R 7\* produced contains the reports against these 3 persons made by passengers as well as ticket inspectors, and I find that all these complaints were genuine ones and these 3 persons were discontinued only after the complaints against them had been duly investigated and after they were given a chance of defending themselves. The book R 7\* is a document that has been kept in the ordinary course of business although I cannot say the same of the other document R 6\*. R 6\* is a book where the decisions against the different employees of the company have been summarised. It appears to have been made for the purpose of this case. If the idea of the officers of the respondent company in making up R 6\* was to furnish the Court with a summary of their decisions against their employees it was a laudable one, but if their idea was to make the Court believe that R 6\* was a book kept regularly in the course of business I think they have failed in their attempt. I find that the 3 petitioners who were dismissed from the company before the general strike of November 21, 1945, are not entitled to any redress from this Tribunal. I dismiss their petition.

As regards the other 11 petitioners too I prefer to accept the evidence of M. Jayasena, the Managing Director of the bus company and of their Branch Manager Perera *alias* Thomas in preference to the evidence of the petitioners. The evidence of these two witnesses is also corroborated to some extent by the evidence of Mr. Kanagaratnam. I am not prepared to hold that Mr. Kanagaratnam's evidence has been made up for the purpose of this case. What appears to have happened is that when there was the order on the respondent company's manager or branch manager to re-employ the strikers the former set about in such a way that they made some of the strikers get disgusted of themselves and give up their jobs under the respondent company. Some of them were asked to wait and they were paid the minimum wages although no work was done by them. Other petitioners were made to give up working under the respondents of their own accord. Some of the petitioners have joined the others not because they have a genuine grievance or because they were refused work but as they could join without additional expense to the petitioners and in order to add weight to the petition. I am not prepared to hold that the excuse given by the respondents for not finding work for some of the petitioners immediately on their coming and asking for work is not a genuine one. The respondents, when they were suddenly faced with the situation of their bus workers striking without any forewarning, had to do their best to get the buses running as early as possible, and they employed outsiders as drivers and conductors. These people worked under the respondent company at considerable risk to their lives as the strikers must have been trying their best to stop them from working. There must have been quite a lot of intimidation and there is a certain amount of justification for the conduct of the respondents in not taking off these workers who came to their rescue at a critical time and giving their places to their quondam employees who had gone on strike. If the excuse given by the respondents is a genuine one, there has been no victimisation.

I dismiss the petition of the other 11 petitioners too. There will be no costs of this inquiry."

**MOTOR CAR ORDINANCE, No. 45 OF 1938.**  
**List of Applications for Licences for Lorries for 1946.**

IN terms of section 46 of the Motor Car Ordinance, No. 45 of 1938, a list of applications for licences for lorries for the rest of the year, 1946, is published below for general information. The following extract from the Ordinance applies to objections against the issue of licences, &c. :—

"46 (2) (a) Any licensing authority, within whose area any part of the area of operation proposed by any applicant for a licence for a lorry is situated, may make objection against the issue of that licence. 46 (2). (b) Any person who is the holder of a valid licence or who is himself an applicant for a licence for a lorry in respect of the whole or any part of the area of operation which is proposed by any other applicant may on payment of the prescribed fee, make objection against the issue of the licence to such other person. 46 (4). Any person who is entitled under sub-section (2) to make objection to the issue of any licence, may, on payment of the prescribed fee\*, inspect the application for that licence at any reasonable time at the Office of the Commissioner: Provided, however, that no fee shall be payable by any licensing authority in respect of the inspection of any application."

Objections must be made in the manner stated below to the Commissioner of Motor Transport, Colombo, so as to be received by him not later than 2 P.M., on FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 15, 1946. 1. Every objection in respect of an application for a licence for a lorry shall be made by a written statement on good and suitable paper which shall be signed by the person making the objection. Where the objection is made by any body corporate or firm, it shall be signed by a person duly authorized in that behalf by such body or a partner of the firm, as the case may be. 2. Every objection shall be made in duplicate and the original shall, where the objection is made by any person other than a licensing authority, bear stamps (uncancelled) to the value of Rs. 2.50. 3. Every statement of objection shall set out the specific grounds on which the objection is based and shall indicate, by reference to the name of the applicant for the licence and to the distinctive number of the motor car the application in respect of which the objection is made. 4. No objection relating to more than one motor car shall be made in any one statement of objection. Any objections not conforming to these requirements will be of no avail.

Objectors under section 46 (2) are requested to state clearly in their objections the facts entitling them to object, i.e., whether they are holders of valid licences or are themselves applicants for licences for lorries in respect of the whole or any part of the area of operation and additional services proposed by any applicant. They are also requested to give the registered number of their vehicles in the area applied for or cite the serial number of their applications as listed in the Gazette.

If the objection is in respect of any application for a licence for a lorry "under construction" the serial number given to the application in the list should be quoted.

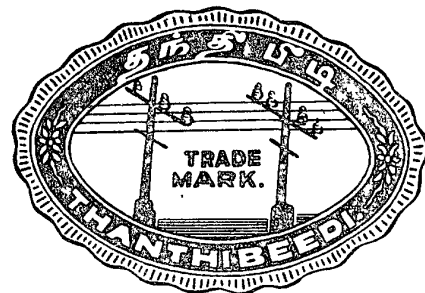

"Oil settling apparatus".

*Abstract.*—The object of the apparatus is to separate the "foots", i.e., the suspended matter in the oil delivered by an expeller press. It comprises a tank provided near one end and above its bottom with a product overflow outlet opening and at a higher level with an inlet opening, an apron mounted in said tank and sloping downwardly from a point between said openings toward the other end of the tank, a horizontal screen above the inlet opening, a receiver below the end of the said screen, and a series of scrapers connected in endless series form and mounted to travel first downwardly along said apron, then horizontally along the tank bottom, then upwardly to and along said screen and adapted to collect solid matter settling from liquid supplied to said tank and to conduct the same to said receiver.

*Abstract.*—The invention relates to a game of chance in which figures are moved along a track, and come to rest against a number.

"Improvements in or relating to rubber sheeting and processes of its production".

*Abstract.*—The object of this invention is two fold:—(a) to produce rubber sheeting having high swelling properties without rapid dissolution in petrol; such sheeting is suitable as self sealing covering for petrol tanks, (b) to produce sheeting which is highly resistant to tear in all directions.

The first kind of sheeting is obtained by applying rubber dispersions suitably frothed to a backing surface, causing or allowing the froth to set to a spongy or cellular structure of irreversible material, compacting the cellular structure in a wet condition and drying the compacted and non porous sheeting. Preferably the frothed aqueous dispersions are those rendered capable of gelling on the application of heat or those which have substances which render them self gelling.

The second kind of sheeting differs from the previous one by having vulcanising ingredients added before frothing, and subsequently vulcanised.
