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PASSED ORDINANCES.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

No. 41 of 1946.

An Ordinance to make provision for the Public and Railway Services and the Electrical Undertakings for the financial year, 1946-47, to authorise the payment by way of advance out of Revenue of moneys required during that financial year for specified purposes, and to provide for the refund of such moneys to Revenue.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:

This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, No. 41 of 1946.

Short title.

Without prejudice to any other law authorising any expenditure, sums not exceeding Three hundred and two million two hundred and ninety nine thousand seven hundred and twenty-nine rupees, Fifty three million six hundred and twenty-three thousand three hundred rupees, Five million six hundred and eighty-seven thousand seven hundred and eleven rupees are hereby declared to be payable out of the revenue and other funds of the Island, the Ceylon Government Railway, and the Electrical Undertakings, respectively, for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1946, and ending on September 30, 1947, and the said sums may be expended as specified in the First, Second, and Third Schedules, respectively.

Appropriation for financial year 1946-47.

(1) In addition to the sums mentioned in section 2, sums not exceeding sixty-five million one hundred and thirtythree thousand two hundred and twenty-six rupees in the aggregate are hereby declared to be payable by way of advance out of the revenue and other funds of the Island, during the financial year referred to in that section, for the purpose specified in the Fourth Schedule.

First Second and Third Schedules.

Payment from and refund to revenue ci advances for purpose specified in the Fourth Schedule.

(2) Where the total sum paid under sub-section (1) by way advance during the financial year beginning on October 1, 1946, and ending on September 30, 1947, has not been refunded to revenue out of the proceeds of any loan authorised to be raised under any written law, that sum or so much thereof as has not been so refunded shall be, and is hereby declared to be payable out of the revenue and other funds of the Island for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1951, and ending on September 30, 1952, in addition to any other sums that may by law be payable, or may by any written law hereafter enacted be declared to be payable, for the service of that financial year.
