All persons who have tendered shall be present or shall be represented by some duly accredited agent at the above-mentioned date, time and place.

2. The person making the tender shall specify therein the rental per month which he is prepared to pay in respect of the lease. No premium shall be payable.

3. The Government Agent may on the date on which the tenders are opened, call upon the successful tenderer to deposit \(\frac{1}{2}\) of the rent tendered for the whole period as security. In the event of such tenderer failing to do so, his tender will be rejected.

4. The person whose tender is accepted shall execute a lease within fourteen days of its being presented to him. In the event of his failure to do so, the Government Agent may cancel the sale and confiscate any deposit paid by him.

5. The proposed lease will contain the following conditions

The proposed lease will contain the following conditions

among others :-

(a) the lessee shall pay the monthly rent in advance at the Colombo Kachcheri on or before the first day of each month.

- (b) if any instalment of rent is not paid in full on the date on which such rent falls due, the lessee shall pay interest at the rate of nime per centum per annum on any part of such rent that is then outstanding until such part is paid in full.
 (c) The lessor (or the Government Agent on his behalf) or the lessee may terminate the lease at any time on giving six month's notice in writing to the other party.
 (d) the lessee shall bear, pay and discharge all existing and future rates, taxes, assessments and outgoings whatsoever in respect of the demised premises.
 (e) the lessee shall not put up any structure whatsoever or construct any roads or make any plantations (temporary or permanent) on the demised premises except with the written permission of the Government Agent, previously obtained.
 (f) the lessee or his workmen shall not cut down any trees that
- (f) the lessee or his workmen shall not cut down any trees that are on the land, nor interfere with any existing fence or
- boundary, picket or drain.

 (g) the lessee shall keep the land clean and in good order in conformity with Municipal Council's Regulations applicable to the land.
- (h) the lessee shall permit the lessor, his agents or surveyors, at all reasonable hours of the day during the continuance of the lease, to enter upon the land for the purpose of inspecting the condition thereof.

- (i) the lessee shall not sub-let, mortgage, sell, donate or otherwise dispose of or deal with his interest in the lease without the written consent of the Government Agent previously obtained.
- (j) the lessee shall fence the demised premises at his own expense if and when called upon by the Government Agent to do so.
