MISCELLANEOUS LAND NOTICES.**Lease of Tonigala Resthouse and Premises.**

6. The lessee will have no claim against the Crown on any account whatsoever.
7. The lessee shall not sublet, transfer or assign his interests in the lease except with the written consent of the Assistant Government Agent, Puttalam, had and obtained.
8. The lease may be terminated on six months' notice being given by either party.

10. The Assistant Government Agent reserves the right to accept or reject any tender without assigning reasons.

Tenders for the Right to Gem.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Government Agent of the Province of Sabaragamuwa will receive sealed tenders, up to 10.30 A.M., on November 20, 1946, for the lease of the right to gem for a period of one year from November 20, 1946, in the under-mentioned Crown lands, situated in the Ratnapura District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa.

2. The amount of the tender should be expressed both in figures and letters and where the amount given in figures differs from the amount in words or no amount is stated in words the tender is liable to rejection.
3. A deposit of Rs. 25 should be made in advance at the Ratnapura Kachehri in respect of each land or bed of stream and the Kachehri receipt in support of such deposit should be attached to the tender form.
4. Tenders should be enclosed in sealed envelopes superscribed "Tender for the right to gem". Tenders must be made for each land or bed of stream separately and the deposit receipt annexed thereto.
5. Any person making tenders will be required to be present in person or satisfy the Government Agent by some duly accredited agent, that the tender is *bona fide* at the time the tenders are opened and registered. In the event of no satisfactory tenders being received, the Government Agent will immediately thereafter consider the sale of the leases by public auction.
6. The Government Agent reserves to himself the right, without question, of rejecting any or all tenders and the right of accepting any portion of a tender.
7. The person whose tender is accepted will be required to pay the full amount of tender at once in cash, and to enter into a lease permit on form G. A. A. 133 for the due fulfilment of the conditions on which the tender is accepted. The deposit of Rs. 25 will be forfeited if the successful tenderer fails to pay the full purchase amount immediately after the sale. The deposit made by unsuccessful tenderers will be refunded.
8. The tenderers whose tenders are accepted should deposit within thirty days from the date of lease sale such security not exceeding Rs. 100 in respect of each land as is approved by the Government Agent, for filling up of pits and for the due observance of the conditions set out in the lease permit and in the tender notice before issue of the permit.
9. The extents given are only approximate and if the total extent of any land should hereafter be found to be less than the extent set forth below, no claim for refund or rebate on account of shortage in extent will be considered unless the variation exceeds ten per centum of the stated extent.
10. The lessee shall be liable to pay for any trees on the land damaged, felled or uprooted during the occupancy of the said lease

11. The lessees should notify the Government Mineralogist, Colombo, the date on which they commence gemming operations and should stop work and give access to the working at any time when required for inspection.
