GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS. PRICE ORDERS.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Seemampillai Francis Chellappah, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) for the Island of Ceylon, do by this Order—

- (i) amend with effect from this date the Order dated February 13, 1945, published in *Gazette* No. 9,373 of February 23, 1945, as amended by any subsequent Order, by the omission from the Schedule to that Order of the items relating to the following drugs:—

 Abidol Capsules per bottle of 100.
 Abidol "C" Capsules per bottle of 25.
 Cod Liver Oil Creasoted Emulsion 8 oz. bottle.

 Liquor Sedans 4 oz. bottle.
 Liquor Sedans 16 oz. bottle.
 Metatone per 12 oz.
 Neo—Silvol Capsules per bottle of 25.
 Palatol Compound 12 oz. bottle.
 Palol 10 oz. bottle.
 Silvol ¼ oz. bottle.

- (ii) fix the prices specified in Columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which drugs of the description specified in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (iii) fix the quantity in Column 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the minimum quantity of drugs of the description specified in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto which may be sold in any part of Ceylon; and
- (iv) direct that clauses (d) to (h) of the Order dated February 13, 1945, published in *Gazette* No. 9,373 of February 23, 1945, as amended by any subsequent Order, shall apply to this Order as though those clauses were here in incorporated.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices above which Electric Torches of the description mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of that Schedule shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;

and every person who sells at any premises Electric Torches of the description mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of the Electric Torches of that description;

- BY (iii.) direct that every person who sells any Electric Torches of the description mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- the date of sale;
 - the description of the Electric Torches sold;
 - the quantity of Electric Torches sold; and
 - the price paid.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do by this Order—

- revoke with effect from this date my Order on Electric Torch Bulbs dated December 20, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,219 of December 24, 1943, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of G. E. C. Torch Bulbs (English) specified in column 1 of the Schedule thereto;
- fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which Electric Torch Bulbs of the description specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- direct that every person, who at any premises in Ceylon, sells Electric Torch Bulbs of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of Electric Torch Bulbs of that description;

(iv.) direct that every person, who sells Electric Torch Bulbs of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- the date of sale;
- the description of the Electric Torch Bulbs sold;
- the quantity of Electric Torch Bulbs sold; and
- the price paid.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- revoke with effect from this date my Order dated March 17, 1945, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,385 of March 23, 1945, in so far as it relates to bicycles of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price above which bicycles of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- direct that every person who at any premises in Ceylon exhibits for sale bicycles of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order for bicycles of that description;
- direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - any sale for the purpose of use of bicycles specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail;
- direct that every person, who sells bicycles of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser of such bicycles, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - the description and quantity of the bicycles sold;
 - the price paid; and
 - the date and place of the sale.
