Food Price Order No. ML-16.

RICE AND WHOLE WHEAT.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

#### Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cathravelu Sittampalam, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) for the Matale District, do by this Order:—

- (1) revoke with effect from August 19, 1946, the Food Price Order No. ML-7 of 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,311 of September 15, 1944, and the Food Price Order No. ML-8 of 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,322 of October 20, 1944, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of Rice and Whole Wheat for the areas mentioned in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (2) fix the prices specified in Columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale price per bag and the maximum retail price per measure above which Rice shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (3) fix the prices specified in columns 4 and 5 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale price per bag and the maximum retail price per measure above which Whole Wheat shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (4) direct that every trader who has in his possession Rice or Whole Wheat in the areas mentioned in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises (store or boutique) a notice in which shall be set out the maximum prices for Rice and Whole Wheat fixed by this Order;
- (5) direct that no person shall sell Rice or Whole Wheat which is adulterated with any other article;
- (6) direct that every person who sells Rice or Whole Wheat by wholesale shall, and every person who sells Rice or Whole Wheat by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that Rice or Whole Wheat a receipt in which there shall be set out:—
  - (a) the date of sale;
  - (b) the quantity of Rice or Whole Wheat sold;
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity of Rice or Whole Wheat sold; and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail, and
- (7) direct that for the purpose of this Order:—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of Rice or Whole Wheat for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of Rice or Whole Wheat for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
  - (c) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure; and
  - (d) the maximum wholesale price which may be demanded for any quantity of Rice or Whole Wheat which is less than one bag shall be determined by reference to the maximum wholesale price per bag fixed by this Order.

## RICE (WHOLESALE).

## THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

## Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) and Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) by section 3 (read with section 2(3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Alfred Silva Kohoban Wickreme, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) Kandy District, and Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Uda Hewaheta Division, Nuwara Eliya District, do, by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date Food Price Order No. KD-1 of 1944 dated February 7, 1944, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,237 of February 11, 1944, fixing maximum prices of rice (wholesale) for the Kandy District and Uda Hewaheta Division of Nuwara Eliya District;
- (2) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto, to be the maximum wholesawee prices per bag above which rice of the description specified in the caption to column 2 of the Schedule hereto, shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (3) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has in his possession at any premises any article specified in the caption to column 2 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of that article;
- (4) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who at any premises has been in the habit of selling any article

specified in the caption to column 2 of the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of that article for sale, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises for a period of three months from the date he last sold that article a notice to the effect that he has no stocks of that article available for sale for the time being;

- (5) direct that no person shall sell rice of the description specified in the caption to column 2 of the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article;
- (6) direct that every person who sells by wholesale rice of the description specified in the caption to column 2 of the Schedule hereto, shall give the purchaser of that rice a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of the sale;
  - (b) the quantity of rice sold;
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold; and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, the sale by wholesale; and
- (7) direct that, for the purpose of this Order—
  - (i.) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale, shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (ii.) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart dry measure, and
  - (iii.) the maximum wholesale price which may be demanded for any quantity of rice which is less than one bag, shall be determined by reference to the maximum wholesale price per bag fixed by this Order;

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 of

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Temporary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, 1945, Coomaraswamy, Deputy Controller of Prices, Colombo District, do by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from August 19, 1945, Order No. CD—2 dated February 5, 1944, in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 9341, 11, 1944; my Food Price Order No. CD—13, February 6, 1945, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 9,369 of February 16, 1945, Food Price Order No. CD—13 dated February 6, 1945, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 9,487 of November 23, 1945, relating to the prices of whole wheat;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per bag of 80 measures above which whole wheat shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (iii.) direct that every trader who sells whole wheat in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises (store or boutique) a notice in which shall be set out the maximum prices for whole wheat fixed by this Order;
- (iv.) direct that no person shall sell whole wheat which is adulterated with any other article;
- (v.) direct that every person who sells whole wheat by wholesale shall give the purchaser of that whole wheat a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) date of sale;
  - (b) the quantity of whole wheat sold;
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity of whole wheat sold, and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (vi.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of whole wheat for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of whole wheat for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
  - (c) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure;
  - (d) the maximum wholesale price which may be demanded for any quantity of whole wheat which is less than one bag shall be determined by reference to the maximum wholesale price per bag fixed by this order; and
  - (e) the maximum prices fixed by this Order for whole wheat which is sold wholesale shall include the container in which such whole wheat is sold.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, William Oswald Stevens, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Galle District, do by this Order—

- (i.) revoke my Order dated October 14, 1943, appearing in *Gazette* No. 9,185 of October 22, 1943, in so far as it fixes maximum prices for sugar of the descriptions and grades specified in the First Schedule hereto;

  - (f) the "maximum wholesale price per cwt. gross" fixed for sales within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo shall apply to all sales by wholesale in whole bags, except sales by an importer to a wholesale dealer;
  - (g) the "maximum wholesale price per lb. net" fixed for sales within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo, shall apply to all sales by wholesale in quantities less than a whole bag, except sales by an importer to a wholesale dealer;
  - (h) the "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail;
  - (i) a "whole bag" shall mean a bag filled with any commodity or article;

- (7) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (i) any sale of any quantity of whole wheat for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (ii) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure; and
  - (iii) the maximum wholesale price which may be demanded for any quantity of whole wheat

which is less than one bag shall be determined by reference to the maximum whole price per bag fixed by this Order.

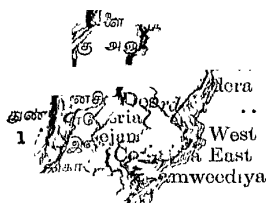

**PRICE ORDER ON 80 AND 112-MEASURE BAGS RICE (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL.)**

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3 (read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Melvill Keverne Trelawny Sandys, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Ratnapura District, do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke the Order dated May 15, 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,272 of May 19, 1944, regarding rice in 80 and 112-measure bags;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price per bag and the maximum retail price per measure above which rice shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in columns 1 and 3 of the Schedule hereto;
- (iii.) direct that every trader who sells rice in the areas mentioned in columns 1 and 3 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises (store or boutique) a notice in which shall be set out the maximum prices for rice fixed by this Order;
- (iv.) direct that no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article;
- (v.) direct that every person who sells rice by wholesale shall, and every person who sells rice by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that rice a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- (a) the date of sale;
- (b) the quantity of rice sold;
- (c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold; and
- (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail; and
- (vi.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
- (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
- (b) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (c) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure; and
- (d) the maximum wholesale price which may be demanded for any quantity of rice which is less than one bag shall be determined by reference to the maximum wholesale price per bag fixed by this Order.
