RICE (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL).

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, NO. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3 read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, John Philip Aserappa, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Batticaloa District, do, by this Order—

- revoke with effect from this date the Order of the Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Batticaloa District, dated March 1, 1945, appearing in *Government Gazette* No. 9,380 of March 16, 1945, fixing the maximum wholesale and retail prices of rice;
- fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the First Schedule hereto, to be respectively the maximum wholesale price per bag of 48 measures (all varieties), per bag of 64 measures (all varieties), per bag of 80 measures (all varieties) and per bag of 112 measures (all varieties) above which rice (all varieties), shall not be sold by wholesale, at the places mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto;
- fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto, to be the maximum retail price per measure, above which rice (all varieties) shall not be sold by retail in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto;
- direct that every trader who sells rice (all varieties) in the places and in the areas mentioned in column 1, of the First and Second Schedules hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises (store or boutique), a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for rice (all varieties) fixed by this Order;
- direct that no person shall sell rice (all varieties) which is adulterated with any other article;
- direct that every person who sells rice (all varieties) by wholesale or by retail, shall on demand, give the purchaser of that article, a receipt, in which shall be set out—
 - the date of sale;
 - the quantity of rice sold;
 - the price paid for the quantity of rice sold; and
 - the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;

KEROSENE OIL (MATARA DISTRICT).

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

By virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) by section 3 (read with the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph 2 of the Defence (Control of Prices) Provisions No. 2) Regulations, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,054 of December 1944, Reginald Alexander Goonewardene, Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Matara District, do,

- make with effect from this date Order dated April 15, 1946, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,549 of May 3, 1946, in respect of kerosene oil for Matara District;
- that the prices specified in column 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum price per four gallon tin with container, the maximum price per gallon *ex-depot*, the maximum price per gallon *ex cart*, and the maximum price per bottle, above which kerosene oil of any brand shall not be sold within the areas specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- that no trader, or tank cartor who hawks kerosene oil, shall sell any kerosene oil specified in the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article or with any other oil of an inferior description or quality;
- that every trader or tank cartor who exposes for sale kerosene oil specified in the Schedule hereto at any premises or from a tank cart that hawks kerosene oil for sale within the areas mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position, at those premises or on the tank cart that hawks kerosene oil for sale a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order for that article;
- (5) that every person who sells by wholesale kerosene oil specified in the Schedule hereto, and any person who sells by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- the quantity of kerosene oil sold;
 - the price paid; and
 - the date and place of sale;
- (6) that for the purposes of this Order that a "bottle" shall be deemed to be one sixth (1/6) of an imperial gallon;
- (7) that any quantity below one bottle, shall be restricted to half bottle, three-quarter and one-quarter bottle only, and the sale of any intermediate quantity shall be prohibited;
- (8) that the prices shall be calculated on the bottle rate in the case of sale by three-quarter, half or one-quarter bottle.
