THREAD.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, NO. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, William James Albert van Langenberg, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date the Order on thread dated May 30, 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,276 of June 2, 1944, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of the articles mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto ;

- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3, and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum price (to a wholesale dealer), the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price of the thread of the description specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule; shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon ;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
- (a) any sale of thread for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale ;
- (b) any sale of thread for the purpose of use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;
- (iv.) direct that every person who sells any thread of any description shall give to the purchaser of such thread, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- (a) the quantity and description of the thread sold ;
- (b) the price paid ;
- (c) the date and place of sale ; and
- (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail, and
- (v.) direct that any trader, who, at any premises, sells any thread of any description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at these premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of thread of that description.

FOUNTAIN PENS.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, William James Albert van Langenberg, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date Order on fountain pens dated May 19, 1945, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,425 of June 29, 1945, in so far as it relates to the maximum price (to a wholesale dealer), the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price in respect of Golden Platignum fountain pens specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3, and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the importer's maximum price (to a wholesale dealer), the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which fountain pens of the description specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale for the purpose of resale or any sale of twelve or more fountain pens referred to

in the Schedule hereto, to any one person in the course of one transaction shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;

- (b) any sale of fountain pens referred to in Schedule hereto other than a sale by wholesale as defined above shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iv.) direct that every person, who at any premises in Ceylon exhibits for sale, fountain pens of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of that description; and
- (v.) direct that every person who sells any fountain pens of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall give to every purchaser of such fountain pens on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the quantity and description of the fountain pens sold;
 - (b) the price paid;
 - (c) the date of the sale; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.
