- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3, and 4 of the Schedule hereto, to be respectively, the Controller's maximum price per bag of 80 measures, the maximum wholesale price per bag of 80 measures and the maximum retail price per measure, above which whole wheat shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order the "Controller's maximum price" shall apply to the sale by the Food Controller or any person acting on his behalf;
- (iv.) direct that for the purpose of this Order, the provisions of paragraphs (iii.) to (vii.) of my Food Price Order No. J—4 of 1944, dated March 4, 1944, and published in Government Gazette No. 9,244 of March 10, 1944, in respect of whole wheat, shall apply to this Order as though they were herein embodied.
