THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASES
ORDINANCE.

Notification.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by regulation 1 of the regulations under sections 2 and 3 of the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance (Chapter 173), published in the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 7,481 of August 28, 1925, I, John Curtois Howard, Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon, do by this Notification confirm the declaration of the "diseased locality" specified in the Schedule hereto, made by the Government Agent, North-Central Province, the proper authority in that behalf, on August 8, 1946.

The area known as Giritale bounded as follows:—

North—by an imaginary line drawn eastwards from the 18th mile post on the P. W. D. road from Polonnaruwa to Habarane to meet the Palugollawela anicut on the Giritale Oya ;

South—by the Yoda Ela ;

East—by an imaginary line drawn northwards from Dambalawewa to meet the Palugollawela anicut on the Giritale Oya ;

West—by the Yoda Ela-Giritale bund and the P. W. D. road from Polonnaruwa to Habarane.
