GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS.

THE RURAL COURTS ORDINANCE, No. 12 OF 1945.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Rural Courts Ordinance, No. 12 of 1945, I, John Curtois Howard, Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon, do by this Order delegate—

- (1) to the Legal Secretary the power of the Governor under sub-section (1) of the aforesaid section in pursuance whereof a person may be appointed to act for any period exceeding seven days as the President or as an Additional President of a Rural Court; and
- (2) to the Judge of each District Court the power of the Governor under sub-section (1) of the aforesaid section in pursuance whereof a person may be appointed to act for any period not exceeding seven days as the President or as an Additional President of any Rural Court over which that Judge has appellate jurisdiction under the provisions of the said Ordinance.

THE RURAL COURTS ORDINANCE, No. 12 OF 1945.

Order.

WHEREAS the areas specified in column I of the Schedule hereto, being areas for which Rural Courts are deemed to be established under the Rural Courts Ordinance, No. 12 of 1945, fall within the local jurisdiction of two or more District Courts:

Now, therefore, I, John Curtois Howard, Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon, do, in the exercise of the

powers conferred on the Governor by the proviso to section 42 of that Ordinance, nominate, in respect of each of the aforesaid areas, the District Court specified in the corresponding entry in column II of the Schedule, as the District Court whereof the Judge or the Judge and each Additional Judge shall have and exercise appellate jurisdiction over the Rural Court of that area.
