The area known as Giritale bounded as follows:

North—by an imaginary line drawn eastwards from the 18th milepost on the P. W. D. road from Polonnaruwa to Habarana to meet the Palugollawela anicut on the

Gritale-oya;
South—by the Yoda-ela;
East—by an imaginary line drawn northwards from
Dambalawewa to meet the Palugollewela anicut on the Giritale-oya;

by the Yoda Ela-Giritale Bund and the P. W. D. Westroad from Polonnaruwa to Habarana.
