KNOW Ye that in pursuance of the provisions of Article 74 of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931, I, JOHN CURTOIS HOWARD, Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon, do by this Proclamation signify the assent given by His Majesty the King, through one of His Principal Secretaries of State, to the Bill intituled "An Ordinance to provide immunity from civil or criminal proceedings in respect of the publication or reproduction of authorised documents", which was passed by the State Council on the Twenty-fifth day of September, One thousand Nine hundred and Forty-six, and was reserved by me under Article 77 of the aforesaid Order in Council for the signification of His Majesty's pleasure.

GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS.

FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.

Notice—Change of Ration.

IT is hereby notified in terms of Regulation 5 of Part II. of Head E and Regulation 4 (1) of Part III. of Head E of the Food Control Regulations, 1938, that as from Monday, October 23, 1946, (Sunday, October 27, 1946, in the case of the Colombo Municipal area) (20th week of rationing of 6th series), until further notice the weekly ration of rice or paddy—

- (i.) which may be sold or issued by way of sale or otherwise, to any person of any class specified in column I. of the Schedule hereto who is over one year of age and is resident on an estate as defined in the Food Control Regulation, 1938, or
- (ii.) which may be sold to any person of any class specified in column I. of the Schedule hereto who is over one year of age and is resident in any area, whether urban or non-urban (other than an estate) in which rationing is in force, and who is the holder of a ration book for a person of that class

shall be the quantity specified in the corresponding entry in columns II. or III. of that Schedule.
