A PROCLAMATION.

J. C. HOWARD.

KNOW Ye that by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 32 (1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 153), I, John Curtois Howard, Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon, do by this Proclamation—

- (1) declare that the road described in the Schedule hereto shall be a "minor crossing" from the date hereof, and that the said "minor crossing" shall be closed by gates, and
- (2) amend the Proclamation under the aforesaid section published in *Gazette* No. 6,084 of November 10, 1905, by the omission, from the Schedule to that Proclamation, of the item relating to "Mahaiyawa and Katugastota" occurring under the heading "Between Peradeniya Junction and Matale".
