THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASES  
ORDINANCE.

Notification.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by regulation 1 of the regulations under sections 2 and 3 of the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance (Chapter 173), published in the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 7,481 of August 28, 1925, I. John Curtois Howard, Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon, do by this Notification confirm the declaration of the "diseased locality" specified in the Schedule hereto, made by the Government Agent, North-Central Province, the proper authority in that behalf, on November 12, 1946.

Schedule.

The area known as D 2 State Farm, Polonnaruwa and Kotaliya in the North-Central Province and bounded as follows:—

West—by Topawewa bund ;

North—by the approach road to Polonnaruwa Rest House from the Habarana-Polonnaruwa P. W. D. road, the P. W. D. road from the junction of this approach road with it to the point where it crosses the D1 Channel from Topawewa, and the D1 Channel up to the point where it crosses the railway line ;

East—by the railway line from the point of this crossing to the Kaduruwela Irrigation road ;

South—by the D2 Channel from Topawewa up to outlet No. 4.
