Food Price Order No. C-105.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices (Food) by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2), I, Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulier, Controller of Prices (Food), do by this Order—

(i.) revoke with offect from this date my Food Price Order No. C-34 of 1944, published in Government Gazette

(i.) revoke with effect from this date my Food Price Order No. C—34 of 1944, published in Government Gazetts No. 9,276 of June 2, 1944;
(ii.) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices above which any bread weighing more than 8 oz., whether forming a loaf or part of a loaf, shall not be sold within the area specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
(iii.) fix the prices specified in column 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices above which any bread weighing 8 oz. or less, whether forming a loaf or part of a loaf, shall not be sold within the area specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
(iv.) direct that when any bread is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of wrapper, if any, in which such bread is sold :

if any, in which such broad is sold;

(v.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has bread in his possession at any premises, shall exhibit in a conspicuous place at those premises a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of bread;
(vi.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any bread shall,

on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out-

(a) the date of sale;(b) the description of the loaves sold;(c) the quantity of the bread sold; and

(d) the price paid for the bread sold.

BONE MEAL (ANURADHAPURA DISTRICT).

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Misc. Articles) by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Samson Felix Amarasinghe, Deputy Controller of Prices (Misc. Articles), North-Central Province, do by this Order

(i.) revoke with effect from this date the Order dated April 21, 1944, published in the Government Gazette No. 9,264 of April 28, 1944, relating to the maximum prices of Bone Meal in the North-Central Province;
(ii.) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum prices above which Bone Meal of the description in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall not be sold in any part of the North-Central Province;

(iii.) direct that every person who sells Bone Meal of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall give to every purchaser a receipt, on demand, in which there shall be set out-

(a) the description and quantity of the Bone Meal sold;

(b) the price paid; and

(c) the date and place of the sale;

(c) the date and place of the sale;

(iv.) direct that every person, who at any premises within the North-Central Province, sells any Bone Meal of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises (store or boutique) a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order for Bone Meal of that description.

Schedule.

Column 1. Description.

Bone Meal steamed or unsteamed, of all grades, having a minimum analysis of 3 per cent. nitrogen and 22 per cent. phospheric acid, any excess in nitrogen to be put against a deficiency in the percentage of phosphoric acid, or vice versa, in a proportion of 4 to 1.

Column 2. Maximum Prices.

Rs. 289 32 nett per ton of 2,240 lb. (including container) gross

Rs. 14.47 nett. per cwt. of 112 lb. gross (including container)

Note.—Any sale of over 10 cwt. shall be based on the price per ton.

Note.—These prices do not constitute fixed price at which the above article must be sold; they are the MAXIMUM prices above which sales cannot take place.
