A PROCLAMATION.

J. C. HOWARD.

KNOW YE that by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 6 of the Village Communities Ordinance (Chapter 198), I, John Curtois Howard, Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon, do by this Proclamation alter and redefine, with effect from the first day of January, 1947, the limits of the Kinigoda Korale village area defined by Proclamation published in Gazette No. 7,506 of January 8, 1926, read with Proclamation published in Gazette No. 9,159 of August 20, 1943, by the exclusion from that village area of the area known as the town of Rambukkana and more fully described in the Schedule hereto.

Schedule.

Limits of the Town of Rambukkana.

North : From a point at the centre of the Rambukkana-Oya where the Walara-Oya meets it, north-eastwards along the centre of the Rambukkana-Oya to the western village limits of the Werellapata (F. V. P. 105), thence eastwards along the western and southern limits of the said village till it meets the western village limit of Godagandeniya (F. V. P. 162).

East : From the last mentioned point southwards along the western village limit of Godagandeniya (F. V. P. 162) till it meets the northern village limit of Beligodapitiya, thence westwards and southwards along the northern and western limits of the said village till it meets the northern village limit of Pinnawala.

South : From the last mentioned point westwards along the northern village limit of Pinnawala, the eastern and northern village limits of Kurempola (F. V. P. 113) the northern village limit of Kudagama (F. V. P. 112) and the southern and eastern village limits of Hurimaluwa (F. V. P. 111) to the centre of the Railway line, thence westwards along the centre of the Railway line to the centre of the Railway bridge at the junction of the Rambukkana-Oya and the Maha-Oya.

West : From the last mentioned point northwards along the centre of the Rambukkana-Oya to the starting point of the northern limit.

THE VILLAGE COMMUNITIES ORDINANCE.

BY virtue of the powers conferred by section 11 (1) of the Village Communities Ordinance (Chapter 198), the Executive Committee of Local Administration, with the approval of the Officer Administering the Government given in pursuance of the powers vested in the Governor by that section, and with effect from January 1, 1947, by this Notification—

- (1) subdivides such of the village headmen's divisions situated in the Kinigoda Korale village area in the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Galboda and Kinigoda Korales in the Kegalla District, as are enumerated in Column I. of the Schedule hereto, into the wards with the limits specified in the corresponding items in Column II. of that Schedule, and
- (2) rescinds the Order relating to the delimitation of wards in certain village areas in the Kegalla District and published in Gazette No. 8,080 of September 21, 1934, in so far as it relates to the Kinigoda Korale village area.




- (1) In the Wards specified in the first column of the schedule hereto the election of a Councillor is contested.

- (5) The situations of the polling stations for all voters in each of the said Wards are specified in the fourth column of the schedule opposite to the name of that Ward in the first column.






