MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

L. D.—O. 6/47.

An Ordinance to amend the Crown Lands Ordinance, No. 8 of 1947.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Crown Lands (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1947. Short title.

2. Section 102 of the Crown Lands Ordinance, No. 8 of 1947, is hereby repealed and the following new section substituted therefor:— Replacement of section 102 of the Crown Lands Ordinance, No. 8 of 1947.

102. It is hereby declared that—

- (a) every public road, carriage-way, cart-way, path-way, path and thoroughfare;
- (b) every bridge, drain, embankment causeway and ditch belonging to or appertaining to a public road, carriage-way, path-way, path or thoroughfare; and
- (c) every road reservation and Crown reservation, are the property of the Crown.

Title to public roads, &c, vested in the Crown.

Objects and Reasons.

Under section 102 of the Crown Lands Ordinance, No. 8 of 1947, all roads are declared to be the property of the Crown. When the Ordinance was framed the real intention was to declare public roads, and not all roads, to be the property of the Crown. The object of this Bill is to give effect to that intention.
