Gunawardene—trustees of the Puspa Puja Kulangana Samitiya—have applied for a lease of about 2 acres from lot 222A in Topo 4 (Insert 20), situated in Koholankala, Hambantota District, for the purpose of extending the Buddhist temple standing on private lot 219.

2. The land applied for has been reserved for the expansion of the temple. The trustees propose to construct a shrine-room, Bo-kotuwa, and a hall on this land, as there is insufficient space for the purpose on the private land.

3. It is therefore proposed to grant the application subject to the following conditions, amongst others:

- (a) Rent: Rs. 75 per annum;
- (b) The lessees shall erect on the land, within 10 years from the date of the commencement of the lease and to the satisfaction of the A.G.A., Hambantota, a shrine-room, Bo-kotuwa, and a hall (hereinafter referred to as the temple);
- (c) The lessees shall use the land as a site for a Buddhist temple and for no other purpose;
- (d) Any antiquities discovered on the land shall be the property of the Crown;
- (e) The lessees shall, within six months of the completion of the temple, dedicate it by deed approved by the Public Trustees. In that event, the land will be sold to the Controlling Viharadhipathi or the Trustee of the temple, as the case may be, in trust for the temple.

4. The lease will be granted unless valid reasons to the contrary are adduced in writing to the undersigned within six weeks from the date hereof.
