KEROSENE OIL.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939. Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Douglas Hastings Balfour, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do by this Order :-

- (i.) revoke with effect from January 1, 1947, my Order dated August 20, 1946, published in Government Gazette No. 9,592 of August 23, 1946, relating to Kerosene oil:
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum price per four-gallon tin, the maximum price per price per four-gallon tin, the maximum price per gallon, and the maximum price per bottle above which kerosene oil of the brand specified in the corresponding entry of column 1 of the schedule hereto shall not be sold (by wholesale or by retail) within the Municipal limits of Colombo;

 (iii.) direct that paragraphs (iii.) to (ix.) of the Order dated February 5, 1943, and published in Government Gazette No. 9,079 of February 5, 1943, regarding kerosene oil shall apply to this Order as though those paragraphs were incorporated in this Order.
