KEROSENE OIL (MANNAR DISTRICT).

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 of 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordmance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Thamotharampillai Chatchithanantham, Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Mannar District, do, by this Order-

- (1.) revoke with effect from January 1, 1947, the Order dated September 24, 1946, published in Government Gazette No. 9,609 of October 4, 1946, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices of kerosene oil fixed therein for the
- (n.) fix the prices specified in Columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the Agent's maximum price per gallon ex Depot, the maximum price per gallon and the maximum price per bottle above which kerosene oil of the description specified in the Schedule hereto shall not be sold (by wholesale or by retail) within the areas specified in the corresponding entry in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto;

(m.) direct that every trader who at any premises within the limits of any area mentioned in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit m a conspicuous place at those premises a notice in which shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order for kerosene oil;

- (iv.) direct that no such trader shall sell any kerosene oil of any brand which is adulterated with any other article or
- with any oil of an inferior description or quality;
 (v) direct that every trader who sells kerosene oil of any brand shall on demand give the purchaser of that kerosene oil a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the quantity of kerosene oil sold,
 - (b) the price paid, and(c) the date of sale;
- (vi.) direct that for the purpose of this Order a "bottle" shall be deemed to be one-sixth (\$\frac{1}{6}\$) of an Imperial gallon; (vii.) direct that sale of any quantity below one bottle shall be restricted to half-bottle and quarter-bottle only and sale of an intermediate quantity shall be prohibited;
- (vii.) direct that price shall be calculated on the bottle rate in the case by half or quarter bottle.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordmance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph 2 of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, published in the Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordmary No. 9,054 of December 21, 1942, I, Augustus Octavius Wirasinghe, Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Galle District, do, by this Order-

(1) revoke with effect from this date the Order dated August 20, 1946, published in the Government Gazette No. 9,594 of August 30, 1946;

- (2) fix the prices for areas specified in Column 1. of the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Schedules to be respectively, the maximum price per gallon bulk and the maximum price per bottle specified in Columns 3 and 4 of the First, Second, Third and Fourth Schedules and Column 4 of the Fifth Schedule referred to, above which kerosene oil of the brands specified in Column 2 of the Schedules hereto shall not be sold wholesale or by retail within the areas specified in Column 1. of the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Schedules respectively;
- (3) direct that every trader who exposes for sale kerosene oil of the brands specified in Column 2 of the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Schedules to this Order, at any premises or from a tank-cart that hawks kerosene oil for sale within the Galle District shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises or on the tank-cart that hawks kerosene oil, for sale a notice in which shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of that article;

(4) direct that no such trader or tank-carter shall sell any kerosene oil of any brand specified in Column 2 of the Schedules hereto which is adulterated with any other article or any oil of an inferior description or quality;

- (5) direct that every person who sells by wholesale kerosene oil of any brand specified in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto shall, and any person who sells by retail shall on demand give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out-
 - (a) the brand of kerosene oil sold
 - (b) the quantity of kerosene oil sold,

 - (c) the price paid,(d) the date of sale;
- (6) direct that for the purpose of this Order a bottle shall be deemed to be one-sixth (\$\frac{1}{6}\$) of an Imperial Gallon;
- direct that sale of any quantity below one bottle shall be restricted to half bottle, three-quarter bottle, and quarter bottles only, and sale of any intermediate quantity shall be prohibited

direct that the price shall be calculated on the bottle rate in the case of sale by three-quarter, half or quarter bottles.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Charles Samson Ranasooriya, Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Nuwara Eliya District, do, by this Order

- (1) revoke with effect from this date the Order made by the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Nuwara Eliya District, published in Government Gazette No. 9,616 of October 18, 1946;
- (2) fix the prices specified in Columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto, to be the maximum price per gallon and the maximum price per bottle above which the kerosene oil of the description specified in the Schedule hereto shall not be sold (by wholesale or by retail) within the areas specified in the corresponding entry in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (3) direct that every trader who exhibits for sale kerosene oil at any premises within the areas specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which shall be set out the maximum price of kerosene oil fixed by this Order;

(4) direct that no such trader shall sell any kerosene oil which is adulterated with any other article or with any oil of any description or quality,

(5) direct that every porson who sells knrosene oil, shall give the purchaser of that oil, a receipt on which shall be set out—

(a) the quantity of the kerosene oil sold;

(b) the price paid; and (c) the date of sale;

(6) direct that for the purpose of this Order a "bottle" shall be deemed to be one sixth (1/6th) of an imperial gallon

(7) direct that the sales of any quantity of kerosene oil below one bottle shall be restricted to half bottle and quarter bottle only, and sale of any intermediate quantity shall be prohibited;
(8) direct that prices be calculated on the gallon rate in the

case of sales of half gallon and above, and on bottle rate in the case of all sales of less than half gallon.

Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscollaneous Articles), Trincomalco district do by this order:—

revoke with effect from January 1, 1947, Order dated August 20, 1946, published in the Government Gazette No. 9,594 of August 30, 1946;
 fix the prices for areas specified in column 1 of the first and the second schedules respectively;

(3) direct that every trader who exposes for sale kerosone oil of the brands specified in column 2 of the first and the second schedules to this Order at any promises or from a tank cart that hawks kerosene oil, for sale, within the Trincomalco District, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises or on the tank cart that hawks kerosene oil, for sale a notice in which shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of that article; (4) direct that no such trader or tank carter shall sell any

kerosene oil of any brands specified in column 2 of the schedule heroto which is adulterated with any article or any oil of an inferior description or quality;

(5) direct that every person who solls by who sale kerosene

oil of any brand specified in column 2 of the schedule horoto shall, and any porson who sells by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out:—

(c) the price paid; (d) the date of sale.

(6) direct that for the purpose of this Order a bottle shall be deemed to be one-sixth (3) of an imperial gallon;
(7) direct that sale of any quantity below one bottle shall be restricted to half bottle, three quarter bottle, and quarter bottles only, and sale of any intermediate quantity shall be prohibited;

(8) direct that the price shall be calculated in the bottle rate in the case of sale by three quarter, half or quarter bottle.

(1.) revoke with effect from January 1, 1947, order dated August 20, 1946, published in Government Gazette No. 9,592 of August 23, 1946, in respect of Kerosine Oil, Matale District;

(ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3, and 4 of the Schodule hereto to be respectively the maximum price per four-gallon tin, the maximum price per gallon and the maximum price per bottle above which Kerosine Oil specified in the Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the areas specified in the corresponding entries in column 1. of the Schedule hereto;

(iv.) direct that every trader or tank carter who exposes for sale Kerosine Oil specified in the Schedule heroto at any premises or from a tank cart that hawks Kerosine Oil for sale within the areas monitoned in the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those promises or on the tank cart that hawks Kerosine Oil for sale a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order for that article;

(v.) direct that every person who sells by wholesale Kerosme Oil specified in the Schedule hereto annexed and any person who sells by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which

there shall be set out—

(a) the quantity of Kerosine Oil sold;

(b) the price paid; and

(c) the date and place of sale.

(vi.) direct that for the purposes of this Order that a "bottle" shall be deemed to be one-sixth (\$\frac{1}{6}\$) of an Imperial gallon;

(vii.) direct that sale of any quantity below one bottle shall be restricted to half bottle, three-quarter and one-quarter bottle only and the sale of any intermediate quantity shall be prohibited; (viii.) direct that the prices shall be calculated on the bottle rate in the case of sale by three-quarter, half or one-quarter bottle.
